- + For eligible associates, OhioHealth will directly pay your tuition to your school up to \$5,250, at more than 50 preferred in-network colleges and universities. This means no out-of-pocket tuition costs.
- + Some of these colleges and universities offer a yearly \$5,250 tuition cap so when you use your \$5,250 OhioHealth tuition benefit, any tuition costs beyond that are covered by the school. That means you may be able to earn your certificate or degree at no cost to you!
- + Tuition reimbursement is still available for all other out-of-network colleges and universities.
- + Eligibility for education benefits begins day one of employment.
- + Eligibility for education benefits is
 - Full-time associates receive \$5,250 per year (64-80 hours per pay).
 - Part-time associates pursuing degrees in identified workforce critical roles will also receive \$5,250 per year.
 - Part-time associates for all other roles receive \$3,000 per year (32-63 hours per pay).
