From Father Joe....

On the second Sunday of Lent, we move from Jesus' retreat to the desert and temptation by the devil to the glory shown in Jesus' Transfiguration. In His Transfiguration, we see an anticipation of the glory of Jesus' Resurrection. The disciples keep secret what they have seen. Not until they also witness His Passion and death will the disciples understand Jesus' Transfiguration. We hear this story of Jesus' Transfiguration early in Lent, but we have the benefit of hindsight. In our hearing of it, we anticipate Jesus' Resurrection even as we prepare to remember Jesus' Passion and death.

This is Commitment Weekend for the Diocese of Wilmington. Unlike the disciples who witnessed the glory of Christ first and later experienced His tragic death and waited in wonder what it all meant, we know the complete story. Jesus rose from the dead. Our knowledge allows us

to witness the transfiguration of life into the glory of Christ. Under the theme "Together in Hope," we are inspired by this powerful message. We are reminded that hope is the foundation of our faith and the light that guides us through all challenges.
