It is fitting that we concluded the Christmas season with the Baptism of the Lord. The Christmas Season celebrated God's pro-

found compassion & humility as He is born into our world to save us. Always before him is the cross and the "sword" that Simeon foretold would pierce Mary's heart and lay ours bare. Christmas Masses were followed by the memorial of St. Stephen, the First Martyr, this year on the weekend we celebrated the Holy Family. #### The Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order Feast Day-February 17

On the feast of the Assumption in 1233, seven members of a Florentine Confraternity devoted to the Holy Mother of God were gathered in prayer. The seven men (Buonfiglio Monaldo, Alexis Falconieri, Benedict dell'Antella, Bartholomew Amidei, Ricovero Uguccione, Gerardino Sostegni, and John Buonagiunta) were prosperous cloth merchants from the city of Florence, Italy. The Blessed Virgin appeared to the young men, exhorting them to devote themselves to her service. They were inspired by this vision of Our Lady and with approval of their Bishop they began a life of prayer and penance on Monte Senario, a quiet mountain outside Florence. In 1240, their community evolved into a religious community called the Servites. The Servites have a special devotion to Mary, the Mother of Sorrows. The Order of Servites was approved by the Holy See in 1304.
