

From the desk of Fr. Russell

"Seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth" (Colossians 3:2)

encourages St. Paul, Put to death, then, the parts of you that are earthly: immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and the greed that is idolatry. Stop lying to one another, since you have taken off the old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed" (Colossians 3:5, 9-11).

We continue to pray for the Holy Spirit to renew us and give us peace.

The last two questions that Aquinas takes up before the precepts of charity are sedition and scandal: "Sedition is a special sin having something in common with war and strife, and differing somewhat from them. It has something in common with them, in so far as it implies a certain antagonism, and it differs from them in two points. First, because war and strife denote actual aggression on either side, whereas sedition may be said to denote either actual aggression or the preparation for such aggression... Secondly, they differ in that war is, properly speaking, carried on against external foes, being as it were between one people and another, whereas strife is between one individual and another, or between few people on one side and few on the other, while sedition, in its proper sense, is between mutually dissentient parts of one people... Wherefore, since sedition is opposed to a special kind of good, namely the unity and peace of a people, it is a special kind of sin" (Q 42 Art. 2 Pt. II-II).

Abraham Lincoln pointed out that our concern should be not whether God is on our side, as He is on the side of all, but that we are on God's side. For this, we rely on God's grace to lead us on the paths of peace.





THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD FEAST DAY - AUGUST 6

While Jesus was in Galilee, about one year before His Passion, He manifested His glory to three of His most beloved disciples (Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, James and John) -the same who were afterward witnesses of His Agony in the Garden. He led them to the summit of Mount Tabor, situated in Galilee. The face of Jesus became resplendent as the sun and His garments as white as snow.



Moses and Elijah appeared at His side and conversed with Him on the death He was to suffer at Jerusalem. Peter exclaimed, "Lord, it is good for us to be here!" He then proposed to erect three tents; one for Jesus, one for Moses and one for Elijah. While he was speaking a cloud enveloped them and a voice was heard saying: "This is My beloved Son in whom I am well pleased; hear Him." The three disciples fell prostrate; but Jesus touched them and commanded them to rise. When they arose, the vision had vanished and our Lord stood beside them in His ordinary guise. It was fitting that those who so soon should behold Jesus in the depths of humiliation to which He was to be subject should catch a glimpse of that glorified humanity and His Divinity, that they might be strengthened.
