A Word From Monsignor Hennessy

Dear Parishioners,

Since I was young, I have always liked the fall, even more than the summer. I liked getting back into a routine and getting ready for school, with all that entailed. I liked seeing old friends and having the chance to make new friends. I liked being able to take the next step and advance a grade. I liked learning new things. And I like to think that enthusiasm lasted more than a month, as homework began to pile up and shorter and colder days began to settle in leading to winter. That part I maybe did not like so much!

As a parish family, the fall remains an exciting time because it presents the opportunity to begin the journey of welcoming new members to our community. I say journey, because we have a process by which those who are not Catholic are invited to learn more about the Faith and our communal life and to take the first steps to discern fully embracing it. This process is called the RCIA – *The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*. It is both for those who are not yet baptized and who are truly at the beginning of embracing the Gospel of Jesus Christ and for those baptized outside of the Catholic Church who now want to come into full communion with the Church. It is also an opportunity for adult Catholics who though baptized have not made their First Holy Communion or been confirmed.

Next month, we will begin the RCIA on October 11th at 6:30 pm in the Narthex. We certainly invite those who know they are ready to begin or continue the process to becoming Catholic through baptism or a profession of faith. We also welcome those adult Catholics who wish to continue with their Sacraments and deepen their understanding and practice of the faith. I would be grateful if you would extend this invitation to your family and friends who may be interested. In the past few years some who have joined the RCIA have been faithfully attending Sunday Mass and have been active in our community in various ways. So we often do not need to look far to find those we need to invite!

In passing along this invitation, it is important to remember that some who participate in the RCIA are still uncertain about what they want to do, and that is okay. We welcome anyone who wants to learn more about the RCIA without making any commitments. We are happy to answer questions and give a clearer understanding of what it means to make this journey to becoming Catholic.

Please pray for all those discerning to take this step. And may we all continue our own journey by daily learning more about the faith and deepening our relationship with Jesus and his Church.

The Gospel: Luke 16: 19-31

This story is unique to Luke's gospel. The rich man is very much like the dishonest steward we read about only last weekend. The closing verse underscores the fact that even miraculous events like the Resurrection do not automatically save people.

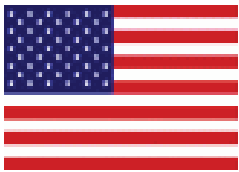

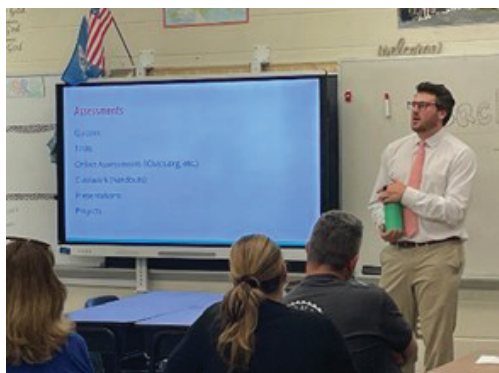

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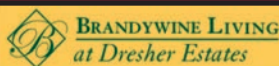
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
