Crown of Thorns Activity

A great Lent and Mission activity, that is *so inexpensive and easy* to make, you can make them with your whole classroom! [They're also great for at home, but easy enough for a classroom environment]

HOW IT WORKS: Every child makes the Crown of Thorns and take it home at the beginning of Lent.

Each time that child does a good deed or makes a sacrifice during Lent, they may remove a thorn from the crown to help Jesus! Students can remove TWO thorns if they make a special sacrifice for the Missions.

What you will need:

- Cheap Play-Doh [red, yellow, blue]
- Toothpicks (cut in half)
- Small paper plates

Instructions are simple!

After mixing the Play-Doh to make a brown color, distribute to the children, with 40 half pieces of tooth picks and a paper plate. Let each student get creative in creating their thorns. Allow each student to take their crown home and don't forget to make one for your classroom.
