Praying Together as Family



Today as we celebrate the Holy Family, I think it is also important for us to celebrate our families. I cannot encourage you enough to pray together as a family. As Holy Cross Father Patrick Peyton used to say, *“The family that prays together stays together.”* He promoted the family rosary earning him the title the ‘Rosary Priest.’ He understood that when a family takes time each day to invoke the help of the Blessed Virgin Mary, while recalling what the Lord said and did to save us, that family will bond together in God’s love and be able to withstand whatever comes its way.

The Church reminds us, *“The Christian family is the first place of education in prayer. Based on the sacrament of marriage, the family is the ‘domestic church’ where God’s children learn to pray ‘as the Church’ and to persevere in prayer. For young children in particular, daily family prayer is the first witness of the Church’s living memory as awakened patiently by the Holy Spirit”* (CCC 2685).

And St. Teresa of Calcutta observed, *“I think the world today is upside down, and is suffering so much, because there is so little love in the homes and in family life. We have no time for our children, we have no time for each other; there is no time to enjoy each other. If we could only bring back into our lives the life that Jesus, Mary and Joseph lived in Nazareth, if we could make our homes another Nazareth, I think that peace and joy would reign in the world.”*

Rezando Juntos En Familia

Hoy que celebramos la Sagrada Familia, creo que también es importante que celebremos a nuestras familias. No puedo animarlos lo suficiente a rezar juntos en familia. Como solía decir el padre de la Santa Cruz, Patrick Peyton, *“La familia que reza unida permanece unida”*. Promovió el rosario familiar, lo que le ganó el título de “Sacerdote del Rosario”. Entendía que cuando una familia se toma un tiempo cada día para invocar la ayuda de la Santísima Virgen María, mientras recuerda lo que el Señor dijo e hizo para salvarnos, esa familia se unirá en el amor de Dios y será capaz de resistir lo que venga.

La iglesia nos recuerda que *“la familia cristiana es el primer lugar de educación en la oración . Basada en el sacramento del matrimonio, la familia es “la iglesia domestica” donde los hijos de Dios aprenden a orar “como la iglesia” y a perseverar en la oración. Para los niños pequeños, en particular, la oración diaria en familia es el primer testimonio de la memoria viva de la iglesia, despertada pacientemente por el Espíritu Santo”* (CIC 2685).

Y Santa Teresa de Calcuta observó: *“Creo que el mundo de hoy esta al revés , y esta sufriendo tanto, porque hay tan poco amor en los hogares y en la vida familiar. No tenemos tiempo para nuestros hijos, no tenemos tiempo para los demás; no hay tiempo para disfrutar de los demás. Si pudiéramos devolver a nuestras vidas la vida que Jesús, María y José vivieron en Nazaret, si pudiéramos hacer de nuestros hogares otro Nazaret, creo que la paz y la alegría reinarian en el mundo.*

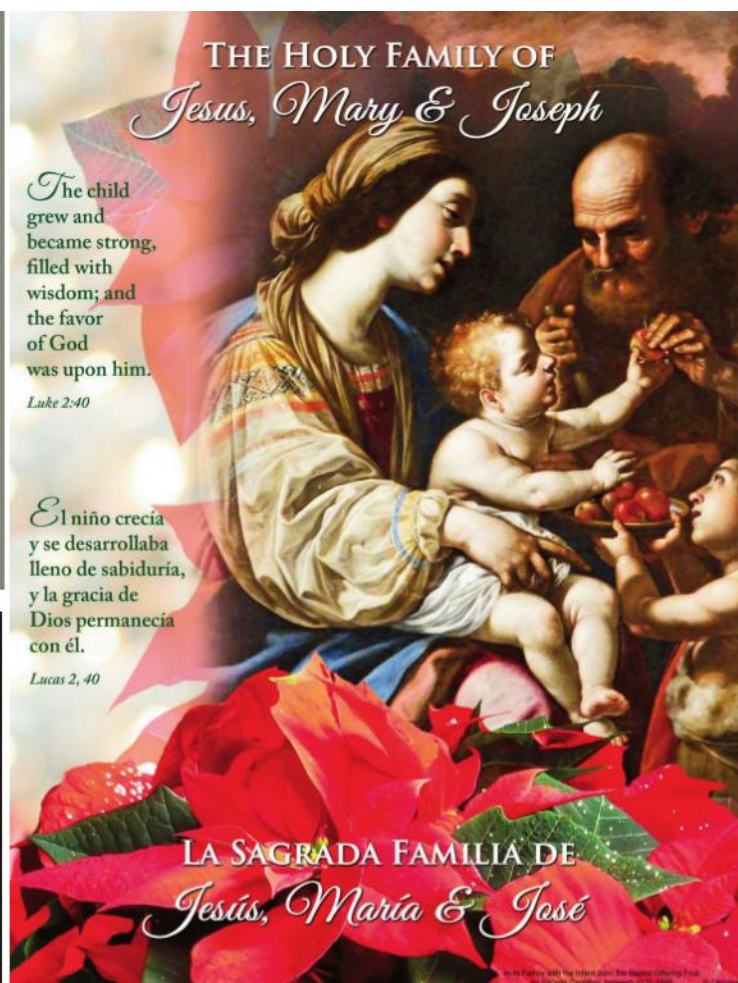
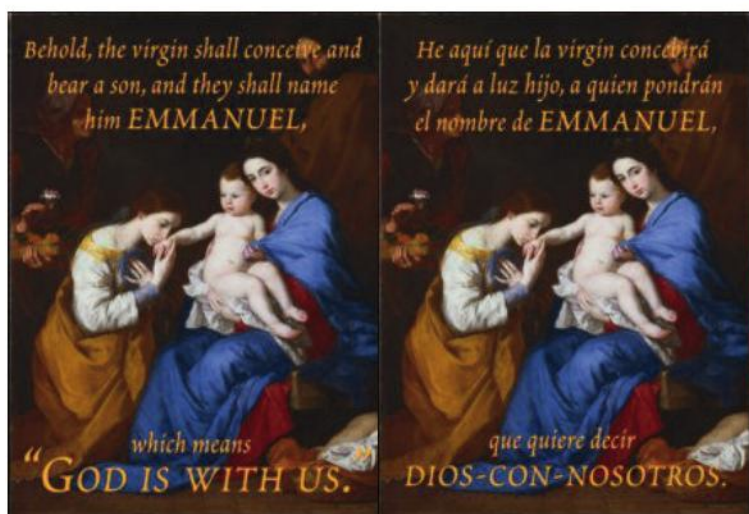

Ask the Apologist Answers

Dear Apologist, I've been away from the Church for a long while. How do I come back?

The first consideration is what it means to “come back”. If it simply means, “I want to be a Catholic in good standing”, then the process is simple. First, do an examination of conscience. I suggest finding a guide by searching online for “NCRegister, Confession Guide for Adults”. Then go to Confession. Either make an appointment with a priest or go to a regularly scheduled time. No matter what you’ve done or how long it has been, you’re only one Confession away from a blank slate.

Keep going to Mass weekly and return to Confession at least annually and you’ll be in good standing. However, there is a danger that doing the bare minimum will seem like a meaningless obligation. Confession and Mass may feel like religious checkboxes, arbitrary hurdles, or perhaps barriers the Church erects between you and God.

So why stop there? A better mission might be; “I want to give my life over to God. I want to be a joy-filled disciple of Jesus Christ.” In that case you can go above and beyond the bare minimum. For instance, learn more about the faith by listening to Catholic Radio (FM 89.1/90.9), reading the Catechism, or attending a parish Bible study. Deepen your faith by attending daily Mass, going on a CRHP retreat, or spending time at Eucharistic adoration. Serve Christ by volunteering at the Matthew 25 Center or the O’Conner House. The best way to return to the Church is to give your entire life back to Christ. In exchange we receive His life, for Jesus said, “I came so that you may have life – and have it more abundantly” [John 10:10]. Not a bad deal.

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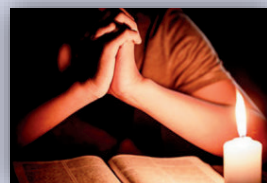

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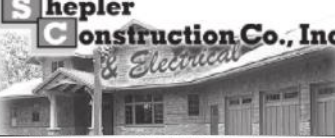
