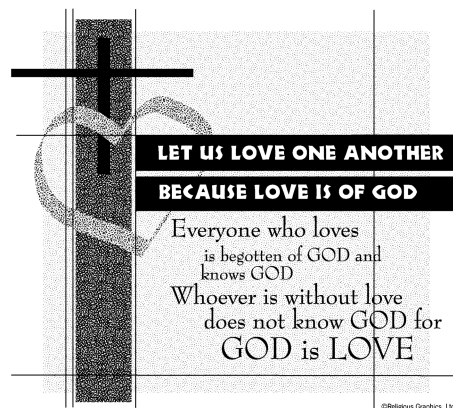

Parents or prospective parents who wish to present a child for Baptism are asked to attend a baptism preparation class.

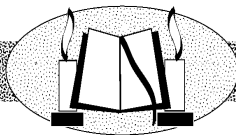
