EMMAUS NIGHTS Starting this Thursday, and running three consecutive Thursdays thereafter, I will be offering EMMAUS. Many of you have experienced these evenings which begin at 6:30pm in the parish hall as we study the readings from the Bible which will be at Mass the following Sunday. At 7:15 PM we then move into the church for adoration of the Eucharist until 8 PM. The nights are geared toward adults but teens are also welcome! You don't need to know a thing about the Bible OR what "adoration of the Eucharist" means...just experience the night!

The name "Emmaus" comes from the Bible when, on Easter night, two followers of Jesus were walking from Jerusalem to their home in the town of Emmaus, seven miles away. As they were walking, Jesus joined them but they did not recognize him. As they walked along Jesus explained to them the meaning of the Scriptures. When they reached Emmaus, Jesus acted as if he was going to continue but was invited to stay with the two travelers. As they sat down for supper, Jesus broke the bread before them and they instantly remembered the Last Supper and that this man in front of them was Jesus, alive and well. Their eyes were opened. So, on Emmaus nights we study the Scriptures...and then adore the Lord in the Eucharist. Some folks come for the full 90 minutes...others come for just the Bible study OR just the adoration. We will gather at 6:30 PM on Thursday July 16th, July 23rd and July 30th. Take this chance to spice up your summer with a little extra time with Jesus!

TECHNOLOGY AT MASS More than once I have heard people coming out of Mass and saying, "Father, I saw so and so looking at their phone during parts of the Mass, can you believe it!?" Well, yes I can as some folks, in this technology crazed culture, use their "smart phones" to pull up the Bible readings and prayers for Mass off the internet or from an application they have on their phone. So, they are, in fact, praying WITH us, not ignoring us! An example of technology put to good use.

<u>WOMEN'S CURSILLO</u> Allow me, for a moment, to talk about an event coming this fall...no, not news on the Vikings drive to win the Super Bowl...but a great spiritual event for women of St. Philip's. Cursillo, pronounced "kur-see-yo", is a Spanish word for "short course."

Cursillo is a weekend gathering of adult Catholics (men and women on separate weekends) who take the time to join others from the parish and diocese in doing a gut check on their faith.

The weekend begins Thursday night with candidates arriving between 6:45 and 7:15. The weekend ends by 6 PM on Sunday. It is held at Sand Hill Bible Camp just south of Fosston. The next Women's Cursillo is October 1-4. I am proud to say my niece, Bobbi Mercil of Detroit Lakes, and our own Sue Hengel will be leading the weekend. Please contact me, Fr.
