Greetings during Natural Family Planning Week, July 19<sup>th</sup> thru 25<sup>th</sup>

During NFP Awareness Week, the bishops of the United States invite us to reflect on the theme, *öNatural Family Planning: Good for the Body, Great for the Soul!ö*

It's God's love that makes us lovable, and allows us to love others as God would love them. When a couple is in love we see love flowing in and through the relationship. During Marriage preparation and at the altar just before the vows, we ask them: are you giving yourselves freely to each other without reservation, without condition, and without hesitation. That is the way God loves us: freely, without hesitancy, reservation or conditions. The Sacrament of Marriage is God's love alive and expressed in everyday life.

*öOur loveö* follows and it is a wonderful thing. I often ask the young couples if they know they are continuing the creative work of God. The *öour loveö* of a couple which flows from God's love is creative and dynamic. When love is shared in an intimate physical way new life becomes possible. The couple provides the egg and the sperm but God provides the soul – the life force that becomes a continuation in the plan of God.

*öGod's Loveö*, becomes *öOur Love*, and it becomes *öOur Family.ö* It is always a bit uncomfortable for a couple when I ask them how they plan to regulate the size and timing of their family. I usually start by asking: who does contraception such as the pill or a condom have the most detrimental effect on: the female or the male? The correct answer is the male. (Want to hear more about this topic? Please call me to discuss)

Our society tells us that sex without the possibility of pregnancy is exciting and fulfilling. It instead creates an environment where either the man or the woman can end up feeling used and trust which is born out of love is violated. We also need to be aware of the moral implications of the spontaneous abortion that occurs due to the fertilized egg not being able to implant in a womb tainted by the pill.

Natural Family Planning is a practical moral option. With NFP we act with the body God has given us – in the way God designed it to function – we cooperate in the love that flows from God through the marriage. Another way to say it is: we need to trust God and to cooperate with God by working with the way in which God made us.

The Couple to Couple League based out of Cincinnati is a wonderful source for information. Their website is: [www.ccli.org](http://www.ccli.org) There is richness in the manner of communication in a marriage when as a couple you discover the language of the body that is spoken through human fertility. Want to enrich your marriage or the marriages of your children – talk about Natural Family Planning.

A little business: Soon we will be able to hear better in the Church. Within the next couple weeks you will see the visible signs of the upgrade. New speakers, acoustical treatment in the choir area will be the visible signs but the invisible sign will be the improvement to the overall sound quality. We will need to hear your comments once it is totally installed. We need to know if there are quiet areas or volume adjustments needed. This has been a long time coming. Thanks to the many individuals and groups that provided input and review of the planned changes.

Also, we will soon be updating our Parish-wide phone system. Our current system is worn-out. Staff spent several months reviewing options before requesting competitive quotes. The new system will help boost productivity and make it easier to reach teachers and staff with features such as Direct-inward-dialing, Voice-mail to e-mail, Paging, Call-forwarding. You will still be able to call the school or Parish Office using the current phone numbers. Technology is moving us forward.

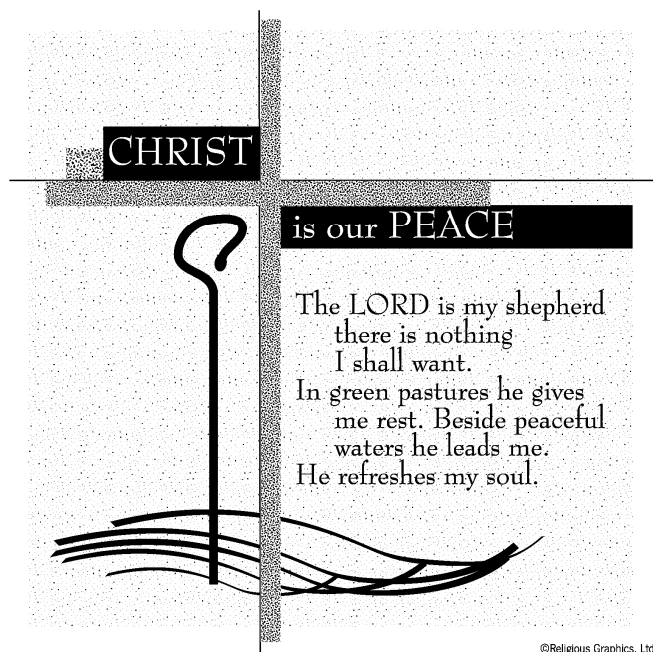

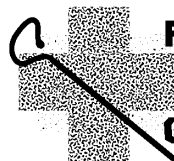
