As a faith community we will take the time and energy to look at our parish mission and ministries. 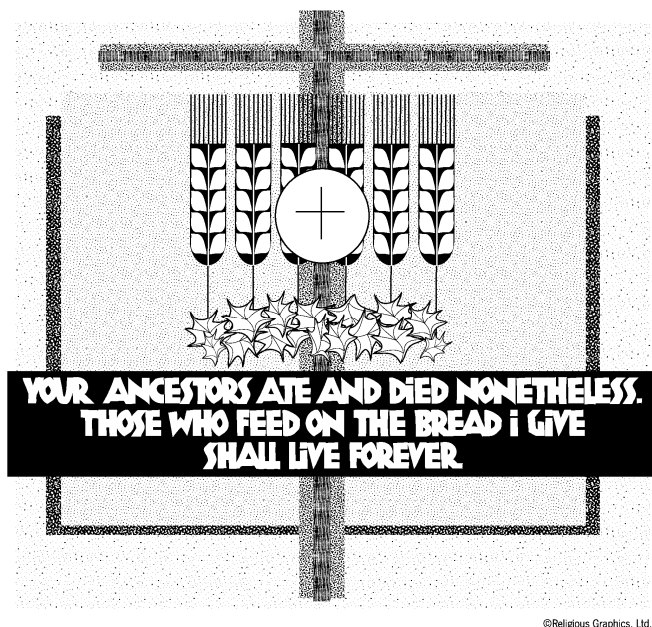
