The powerful witness of a little boy.

This past Monday I had the privilege and honor of presiding at the funeral of Joseph James Collyard. Joseph was just a few weeks from being delivered when he died in his Mother's womb. What always touches me the most when I have such a funeral is the amount of grief shown by so many who attend.
