(Campus and Adult Faith Director) Blake Quick is joining the parish on May 23rd. Blake and family are active members of our parish. His connection as a student at BSU will help him in serving others. Blake looks forward to sharing his faith in Jesus.

Celebrate! With the invitation to all BSU and NTC to join with our parish in liturgical celebrations this fall we needed to adjust the parish Mass schedule effective June 1st. (Details are inside)

Now for some serious topics: This week we received a note from Bishop Hoeppner covering two topics related to priests. Here is a direct quote from Bishop: õI am saddened to let you know that last Friday afternoon (April 29), the Diocese of Crookston was served papers through the office of Mr. Jeffrey Anderson, notifying us that the Diocese and St. Mary& Parish, Red Lake, are being sued due to alleged sexual abuse of a minor by Father Pat Sullivan during Father& tenure at St. Mary&s, Red Lake. Because of this allegation, in accord with the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* and the corresponding *Norms*, and our diocesan policy, I have placed Father Pat on Administrative Leave. Father Pat denies any wrongdoing. We will follow our diocesan policy for dealing with such matters. Please keep in your daily prayer Father Pat, the faithful of St. Elizabeth Parish, Dilworth, St. Andrew Parish, Hawley, St. Mary& Parish, Red Lake and all those involved. And pray that the truth prevail and that this matter be quickly and fairly resolved.ö

The second item to make the news is in regard to Father Jeyapaul. Again a quote from Bishop Hoeppner: õI thought it important that I inform you as your bishop that I have been in contact with the bishop in Father Jeyapaul& home diocese in India and have been assured that he has not assigned Father Jeyapaul to public ministry. In fact, the bishop has ordered Father Jeyapaul to have no ministry in any parish, including saying Mass. He has further ordered Father Jeyapaul to have no contact with minors. He has directed Father Jeyapaul to live in a home for retired clergy. õSuspensionö is a technical term in Canon Law, and although Father Jeyapaul& suspension has been lifted, the severe restrictions on his living and acting mentioned above are firmly in place. At no time after returning to India has Father Jeyapaul been assigned to public ministry.ö

Pentecost is next Sunday! It is the Holy Spirit that fills us with Faith, Hope, and Charity. You can tell by the cover article this week a lot happens in Godøs parish. Thank you for your faithfulness, and your witness to Jesus alive and well. Please keep your prayer life strong.
