If so, have you ever thought "Do I want to be baptized? Do I want to be able to receive the Eucharist? Do I want to be in full communion with the Catholic Church?"

Maybe your spouse is Catholic and you have been coming to Mass with him/her for fifteen years, or maybe you are engaged and soon to be married to a Catholic. Maybe you just started coming to Mass here at St. Philip's with a friend or you were baptized Catholic and left the church for some reason before being confirmed. Whatever your situation, we are willing to work with you, to help you learn what the church believes and holds sacred. We are here to help you determine if God is calling you to full communion with Him in the Catholic Church.

RCIA or Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is designed to help adults who want to know more about the Catholic Church and potentially become members in full communion with the Catholic Church to do so. Our program here at St. Philip's is called *RCIA and Beyond*, because it is also open to Catholics who are already in full communion with the church to come to the sessions just to learn more about their Catholic faith and the teachings of the Church.

Our new round of classes is set to begin in June. We have sessions scheduled the 2nd and 4th Thursday evening and the 2nd and fourth Sunday mornings of each month. The Thursday and Sunday morning sessions will be duplicates so you may attend which ever session better fits your schedule. The first sessions are scheduled for Thursday, June 9th at 6:30 PM and Sunday, June 12th at 10:15 AM. During Session 1 we will take a quick tour of the church and entertain any questions that you may have. Session 2 is scheduled for Thursday, June 23rd and Sunday June 26th and the topic is God the Father & Creator. The program is actually designed so that you may join anytime during the year and also then be accepted into the church when you feel you are ready, not just at the traditional time which is at the Easter Vigil Mass.

Another opportunity that I would like to make all of you aware of will be happening after our new Tuesday evening Masses. Beginning on Tuesday, June 7th, we will be offering Mass at 6:30 PM. After this Mass and for the next seven weeks we will be offering, *Mary*, *A Biblical Walk With the Blessed Mother*. This is a video Scripture Study, guided by Dr. Edward Sri. In this study you will see what life was like for Mary and understand how she felt at each dramatic moment in Scripture, learn why Mary is such an essential part of our Catholic Faith, see the significance of Mary as you explore the biblical roots of our beliefs about her, deepen your devotion to Mary as you discover our Blessed Mother in a uniquely personal way and be drawn closer to Christ as Mary leads you to a more profound and personal relationship with her Son.

You may attend all eight of these sessions or you may attend just the ones that fit your schedule. If you plan to attend most or all of them and would like a book to help you study and more closely follow along with the study, please call Deacon Kermit at the Parish Office to order a book. The cost of a book will be \$28.

ENDING ABORTION THE CHURCH'S WAY

The premise of *Priests for Life* is that abortion will end through the Church, because Christ has conquered death, and it is He who works through each of us to bring this victory to every segment of our society. The activity of the People of God to end abortion is not primarily a response to *Roe v. Wade.* It is, rather, a response to Jesus Christ.

This response, of course, overflows the visible boundaries of the Catholic Church. Pope John Paul II, in *The Gospel of Life,* told us, "No single person or group has a monopoly on the defense and promotion of life. These are everyone's task and responsibility." (EV 91). He says this after asserting that the effort must be ecumenical and, in fact, must include the involvement of all people of good will.
