Happy Third Sunday in Ordinary Time!

January 22, 2017

Spring is here... well maybe not. We have been blessed with some great weather this week.

In this week's Gospel reading Jesus is calling the first of his disciples to leave their nets and come and follow him. They immediately get up and leave everything and follow him. What is Jesus calling you to? And are you responding like Peter, Andrew, James and John?

If you have never attended one of our Parish Koinonia Retreats I would like to encourage you to consider investing 48 hours in your relationship with Jesus! This retreat experience has certainly had a very positive effect on my faith and on my relationship with Jesus. Here are some comments from several of your fellow parishioners about what Koinonia has done for them:

It's taught me that a faith community can mean people of diverse interest coming together to worship and grow in the Lord. Truly, through Koinonia God has taken me from glory to glory to glory. I've learned of a rich and everlasting love that only my heavenly father can provide. I've grown deeper in my Catholic faith and experienced the promises of God by becoming his servant. God is good and he reveals himself to us in different ways throughout our lives. Koinonia is that way for many who are seeking to find him.*
- ✠ *I had no idea what to expect from Koinonia other than faith stories would be shared. I found a deeper personal spirituality through a greater gratitude for the grace of God in my life. Also, I was introduced to, welcome and embraced by a larger Koinonia community, and knowing that their prayer and support would continue to be a part of my life is incredible.*
- ✠ *Koinonia has meant a great deal to me because it gives me a reason to get to know God and others in a prayer family. It gives me a reason to be with others in faith and helps me get through some rough times that have happened in my life.*




