March 19, 2017

It important to check in with someone on our Lenten journey. We can try on our own but we do better when someone else knows what we are doing and asks us for a report. So how are you doing on the Lenten journey? Have you been able to stay away from chocolate, or have you said those prayers for 6 minutes a day, or have you complemented your children every day? Personally I changed mine last weekendô I was struggling so I mixed it up and now am doing fineí just ask meí It keeps me on trackí.

Chris and Tony from the õCasting Nets parish missionö just sent us more of the prayer cards featuring St. Monica and St. Ambrose. If you recall the story: St. Monica prayed faithfully for her songs conversion for many years. In order to answer her prayer God sent St. Ambrose. Augustine would not listen to his mother but he listened closely to Ambrose. As a parent sometimes we need someone else to speak so our children will listen. If you want a set of prayer cards ask at the office or call and we will mail them to you. The information station will also have some on hand.

The power of prayerí would you like it if someone prayed for you everyday? Not just once but 10 times a dayí Chris and Tony sent 10 bundles of the postcards that send a message: õI love you, I prayed for you todayöí It is simple you say a prayer 10 times and market it off on the card after you say a thousand prayers you mail the postcard to the person so they know you have been praying for them. When I get a card that says  $\exists$  prayed for youö I give thanks for the person: it makes my day.

Did you get a copy of the new book: **Everyone Needs to Forgive Someone**? I gave each of my children a copy. My son was flying to Canada on business and was reading the book in the airport and on the plane. He said people struck up conversations based on cover of the book. A fellow passenger wanted the copy when he noticed my son had finished. Guess who wants another copy? Be sure to share the book after you have read it, with someone else who may need to forgive someone.

Speaking of forgiveness, a reminder that on <u>March 31 from 7 AM to 8 PM</u> there will be as many as 3 different priests every hour available to hear reconciliations. You are invited to attend at anytime during the dayí If you can: celebrate Mass at 8:30 AM, or Stations of the Cross at 2:30, or come to hear Brendan Case at 6:30 in the eveningí Fish fry goes from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PMí spend some time or the day at St Philipsí

Some things to think about: If God was trying to tell me something, would I know? If God were reassuring me or challenging me, would I notice? It is important to ask for grace to be free of my own preoccupations and activities and to be open to what God may be saying to me. Tell God: How I am really feeling... Lighthearted? Heavy-hearted? I may be very much at peace, happy to be here. Equally, I may be frustrated, worried or angry. I need to acknowledge how I really am. It is the real me that the Lord loves.

A Daily Prayer: Father in heaven, I ask you to send me your Holy Spirit to be with me all during this day. May all my intentions, everything I do, all I say and think, be for your greater glory and praise. Unite me with your Son, Jesus Christ, who came to serve and not to be served, offering His life for people everywhere.

Jesus Loves You and so do I! Blessings, Fr. Chuck




