A note to daily Mass goers, there is no Mass this Monday, April 3rd.

Members of the parish will present the "Living Stations of the Cross" on Friday, April 7th at 7pm. Year after year this powerful presentation has helped us all prepare for the Holy Week which follows. Thank you, in advance, to all those who sacrifice their time and talent to make the Stations so meaningful.

Holy Week will soon be upon us! Palm Sunday weekend is April 8-9. The Mass of the Lord's Supper is celebrated at 7 PM on Thursday, April 13th. Good Friday we will have two services (Mass is not celebrated on Good Friday) at 3 PM and 6:30 PM. The Easter Vigil Mass begins in darkness at 8:30pm on Saturday, April 15th. Bishop Hoeppner will be here at St. Philip's on Sunday, May 21st at 2 PM for Confirmation. We keep all our youth in our prayers as these great days approach!

Please keep in your prayers Robb Naylor who is preparing for ordination to the Permanent Diaconate on Saturday, June 10th in Crookston. 




