It is hard to comprehend that Lent is almost over. It seems to have gone by very quickly. Now comes a very busy and exciting Holy Week. Today we proclaim the Passion of our Lord. The first reading of our Lord's sacrifice and suffering for us.

Monday evening, April 10th at 6:30 PM, is the Chrism Mass. This Mass is held at the Cathedral in Crookston with Bishop Hoeppner presiding. During this Mass the Bishop consecrates the Sacred Chrism and the Oil of the Infirmed, and the Oil of Catechumens are blessed. We will use these oils in the celebration of the Sacraments here in our parish for the next year. Also, the priests of our Diocese will be called to renew publicly their priestly promises. I strongly encourage you to take part in this beautiful liturgy!

Thursday evening the 13th, begins the Sacred Paschal Triduum, with the celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 PM. During this Mass we celebrate the *Washing of Feet* and the institution by Jesus of the Eucharist.

Friday the 14th, is Good Friday, the one day during the year that Mass is not celebrated. At 3:00 PM and again at 6:30 PM there takes place the celebration of the Lord's Passion consisting of three parts, namely, the Liturgy of the Word with the proclamation of the Passion, the Adoration of the Cross, and Holy Communion. Saturday the 15th at 8:30 PM, comes the culmination of all we have been preparing for during the season of Lent, the highlight of our entire liturgical year as Catholics. We celebrate The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night, the greatest and most noble of all solemnities. So many exciting things happen during the Easter Vigil Mass, from the lighting of our new Easter Candle and procession into the church, to the singing of the Easter Proclamation and Liturgy of the Word which envelopes the history of our faith, followed by the Baptismal and Confirmation Liturgy through which we welcome new members into our faith community. This is a wonderful time to celebrate these sacraments as we celebrate our Risen Lord having conquered death and bringing new life.

Sunday the 16th, we celebrate our Risen Lord with our three Easter Sunday Masses at 7:30, 9:00 and 11:00 AM.

I encourage you to take part in as many of these wonderful liturgies as possible. I also encourage you to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation before the Triduum begins so that you are ready to celebrate the new life which our Risen Lord brings!

May you have a blessed and Happy, Holy Week and Easter,






