

Research shows us that ACEs can greatly impact our overall wellbeing, leading to asthma, diabetes, anxiety, life dissatisfaction, and more. Come learn about how ACEs affect the brain and communities, the church's history in ACEs, and, most importantly, what we can do about them now! This event is for anyone 16-years-old or older. 




