Louann McGlynn 218-281-7895 Over the past few weeks, I have had the opportunity to put together a self-evaluation for the seminary that I attend. My summer assignment is to work with the parish and with the pastor, and at the end of the summer I get credits for õcompletingö my requirements. The school requires that I look back at what I have done over this summer and reflect on myself and how I have changed or grown. After completing the self-evaluation (3 pages) I send it off to the school and they meet with me to discuss how the summer has gone. I am always amazed at the process of writing down how I think I have grown or how I think I have changed over the course of a summer!

One question in particular stood out to me, õIn what ways have I grown in spirituality (includes Liturgy of the Hours, Mass, and personal devotions?)ö This question really led me to ponder and reflect on ways that I have grown in my prayer life through the course of the summer. I have had many opportunities to pray and to lead prayer, but I found myself asking the question õHow have I grown in my prayer life?ö My prayer for this summer has been to increase in humility as a way of decreasing pride. How does humility counter-act pride?

There are two prongs of humility. The first is to say that God is God. When pride steps in, one says that I can handle this on my own, I know what is best, and there is no need for anyone elseí Prayer provides the perfect opportunity to stand face to face with God and to admit that He is the One who is in control. As I reflect on humility and pride, I am drawn to the story in Genesis of Adam and Eve. The pride enters in through Adam and Eve thinking that they know more than God. And humility enters in when they stand before God and admit that they made a mistake. Adam and Eve were able to stand before God and say that they made a mistake. God spoke to them about the garden and what would happen if they ate the fruit, and God followed through with His word.

The second prong is that we are not God. That means for us that we depend fully and completely on God for everything. This is where our pride can enter in and tells us that we are good enough to do it on our own. In order to put pride in its proper place in our lives, it is important that we recognize that we can do nothing apart from God. St. Thomas Aquinas calls this the contingency of God. All things rely on God for their existence and everything can point back to God for its origin. God is the One whom all things rely.

An image that someone shared with me to recognize that God is God and I am not is to look in the mirror. When I look in the mirror I can see flaws, I can see my mistakes, and I can see my pride, but I can also see that God is in love with me. In the midst of my sins, He still picks me up again and again and tells me that He loves me. For that, I am incredibly grateful! We are not called to perfection, but we are called to holiness! May we strive this summer to be holy people that know we are loved by our Redeemer!




