Greetings on this Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time:

August 13, 2017

Jesus stretched out his hand and caught Peter, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" Most of us could substitute ourselves for Peter in this question from Jesus. O, Deacon Kermit, why did you doubt? The doubt happens less as I grow in my faith life. As I invest more time in my prayer life and share more time in the chapel in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. But I wonder what would happen if Jesus were to call me, out of the boat, to come to him on the water. Lord, I do believe, help my unbelief.

This weekend, Sunday, August 13th, at 10:15, we will begin our RCIA and Beyond sessions for the year. We will gather for our first session in the St. Kateri room.

If you are an adult who has never been baptized, or have been baptized but have never been confirmed in the Catholic Church and are interested in becoming an active, participating member of the Catholic Church, RCIA is for you. RCIA and Beyond may also be for you if you are already Catholic, but would like to know more about your faith, your church or your God.

RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Through the process of attending these educational sessions, participating in the Rites and receiving the sacraments of initiation, which are the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, you will have the opportunity to become a practicing Catholic. And then to be able to fully participate at Mass, to receive the Body and Blood of Jesus, and in all of the Sacraments.

You may be in a situation like I was at one time. I grew up in the Lutheran Church. Then I was blessed by God when he brought Marlene and I together. Marlene had been raised Catholic and so we began going to Mass together. We were married in the Catholic Church, attended Mass regularly and actively participated in the life of the Church. However, it was many years before I took the step to be confirmed in the Church and to become a full active participating member, able to participate fully in all of the Sacraments. I am very glad that I did. It is a blessing to receive the Eucharist, to celebrate Reconciliation and also to receive the Sacrament of Anointing. And for me, it even lead to me hearing God call, and me answering the call to the Sacrament of Ordination.

I know that there are several men and probably some women reading this who may be married to a Catholic and do not know if being Catholic is right for them. I invite you to come and see. Check out a few sessions of RCIA and Beyond. Ask some questions and hopefully get some answers. Take it to God in prayer! Ask God if it would help you personally and your relationship with your spouse if you were to become Catholic so that your family could worship fully together. You are welcome to come to all of the sessions that you want before making any commitment to join the Catholic Church.

Please join us for RCIA and Beyond. We meet at 10:15 on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month. If you have any questions please call myself (441-4903) or Deacon Robb (441-4904).




