Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

September 17

Most of us have lived with some form of financial debt. It might be the mortgage, the car payment, or maybe a student loan. We we become accustomed to debt, and to getting reminders to pay them. A fear that many of us have, is that something might happen where we we not able to repay what we owe.

So, imagine, then, if you found a letter in your mailbox telling you that all your debts have been paid in full. Our first reaction would probably be, õWow!ö Our second reaction might be õwhereæ the catch?ö

Think about that considering today Gospel, where the servant big, unpayable debt is graciously forgiven by the king. While the servant has a sense of relief, he doesnot understand that there *is* a catch to all this. He must forgive the debts of others, just as he has been forgiven by the gracious king. That the catch for all of us: to realize that in His great mercy, God has forgiven our sins, and so we are called to show that same kind of forgiveness to others.

It's not pleasant to focus on our own sinfulness. In the back of our minds, we know ito there, but wend rather focus on the good in ourselves. Yet, every now and then, we have to stop and think about the reality that we do, in fact, sin. We acknowledge this, as we ask for Godos mercy and forgiveness in the Penitential Rite at Mass. We realize that Jesusomercy is awesome, and in that realization, we understand that not only are we forgiven, but that we must be generous in forgiving others.

In this weekendøs Gospel, we hear Jesus speak about the broadness of the forgiveness we are called to offer. We are called to forgive not just once i not just seven times i but seventy-seven times. We are called to forgive overwhelmingly, just as the king forgives the servant in the parable, just as God forgives each of us.

Jesus shows us the way, as he forgives the woman caught in adultery, forgives Thomas in his doubting, and forgives Peter for denying him three times. Jesus forgives us. How different would our world be if we practiced this kind of forgiveness all the time?

The Eucharist is a sacrament of forgiveness. In it, we acknowledge our debts, and through it we receive the Lordøs forgiveness. In the Eucharist, we come to know we are forgiven so we can go out into the world and generously love and forgive *others*.
