October 29, 2017

November is knocking at the door. All Saints Day! All Souls Day! The Mass of Remembrance, Thanksgiving... It's the day before Thanksgiving, and the butcher is just locking up when a man pounds on the door. "Please let me in," says the man. "I forgot to buy a turkey, and my wife will kill me if I don't come home with one." "OK" says the butcher. "Let me see what's left." He goes into the freezer and discovers that there's only one scrawny turkey left. He brings it out to show the man. "That one's too skinny. What else have you got?" the man asks. The butcher takes the bird back into the freezer and waits a few minutes, then brings the same turkey back out to the man. "Oh no," says the man, "that one doesn't look any better. You better give me both of them."

At our teaching masses, I have used the imagery of how crowded it can get around the altar when Jesus arrives and brings with Him all the saints and angels. I read an article in which the author noted it is getting even more crowded as each year God calls home more and more of His sons and daughters. With All Saints Day! All Souls Day! The Mass of Remembrance! dedicated to the remembrance of those gone before us: I find it helpful to reflect on how much God loves us that He would die so we could live eternally. And how He would rise from the dead so we can see that death does not have a hold over us. There is so much hope and peace we can find in the salvation promised by Jesus. Where love is, there God is found. We can learn so much from those who have gone before us... we just need to listen... we just need to be quiet and meditate on the joy, light and example they bring.

When someone dies there is the pain of separation: knowing we will not be able to hold them, we will not be able to hear their physical voice. I may have used this quote from Gabriel Garcia Marquez in the past but it still speaks volumes to me: *"Always say what you feel, and do what you think is good and right. If I knew that today would be the last time I'd see you, I would hug you tight and pray the Lord be the keeper of your soul. If I knew that this would be the last time you pass through this door, I'd embrace you, kiss you, and call you back for one more. If I knew that this would be the last time I would hear your voice, I'd take hold of each word to be able to hear it over and over again. If I knew this is the last time I see you, I'd tell you I love you, and would not just assume foolishly you know it already."*

Deacon Mark did a beautiful job on our parish mission. Thank you to all who attended and were part of learning how to be in service to others in the mission of the church. One of my takeaways became the thought for a challenge... God operates in a spirit of love, mercy and forgiveness. The challenge is for each of us to tell 5 people "Jesus loves you and so do I", 5 different people "thank you for your witness of Jesus Christ alive in the world" and 5 different people either "I forgive you" or "Please forgive me",

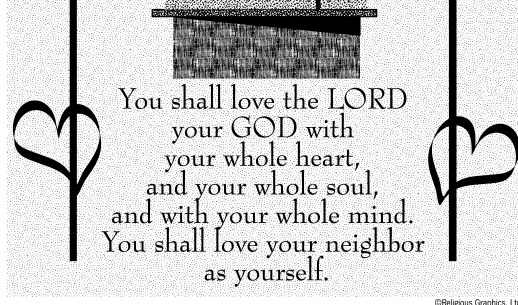
Deacon Mark mentioned how that love and outreach would spread quickly. If each of us reached out to 15 people with God's spirit of love mercy and forgiveness, how many souls would be touched? Are you willing?

Be Good, Be Safe, Be Loving, Be Kind, Be Gentle, Be Compassionate, Behave, and if you do not... remember that is why we have reconciliation... Father Don and I will meet with you anytime to celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation...
