Greetings on this Third Sunday of Easter

Do you consider yourself a sinner or a saint? Or perhaps both, since each of us is probably a sinner and a saint. Sacred scripture says "All have sinned and are deprived of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). All means everyone - you and me.

The word saint comes from the Latin word for "holy." St. Paul addressed his letters to the various Churches of his time, such as the Romans, Corinthians, Ephesians, and others, to the "holy ones" in those cities. He called them "holy" not because they were without sin, but because despite their faults, they sincerely loved God and wanted to obey His commands. The holiest saints are those that see their own imperfections and continue to try and overcome them with God's help. They recognize their sinfulness and come to church to receive the grace they need to become the people they want to be ... to be the people God wants them to be.

What sort of image does our St. Philip's parish project in our community? Are we a "hospital for sinners", or a "service station" where saints can be filled-up to spread the gospel? Certainly, our Church is a hospital for sinners ... a Healing Church. We come because we need healing; we come to seek God's forgiveness. We recognize our sin and ask for God's forgiveness. As a community, we help each other heal by welcoming and listening with compassion, or by serving as ushers, greeters, lectors, singers, or teachers. Our healing Church is a caring Church ... an active and involved Church.

Also, our Church is definitely like a service station. We offer a "spiritual fill-up." We come in need. We are baptized and confirmed into the community of worship. We come to get cleaned-up in the penitential rite, reconciliation or anointing We come to be filled with the Spirit and have our vocations in life strengthened. We come to share Christ with fellow believers. Then, we go out and bring Christ and His Gospel to others.

So, as we attend Mass and celebrate the Eucharist, we must never forget that Christ told us that those who eat His flesh and drink His blood will have eternal life. There is no healing greater than this, and it's ours, right here in our Mass ... where saints and sinners are one.
