My Two Cents by Fr. Don Braukmann

The Feast of Corpus Christi (The Body of Christ)

Years ago, when studying in the Holy Land for a semester during seminary, an Arab man came up to our group, seeing the crosses around our necks and holding Christian books and said, "I drank the blood of Jesus once!" and walked away.

Of course, being in the middle of Jerusalem near the controversial "Dome of the Rock" I first thought the man was a terrorist and I was about to meet my maker! Once I got past my prejudice and as he walked away I began to think of what he said.

I don't know any details of his experience...it seemed, for him, a once in a lifetime experience he had with Christian folks, possibly Catholic, who shared Communion with him.

Would I ever say to people "I drink the blood of Jesus?" Never have and can't say I ever would even though it is true! We often say, "I go to Mass and receive Communion," but are seldom so blunt as the man in Jerusalem.

As Catholics, "Eating the Body of Jesus" and "Drinking the Blood of Jesus" are central events in our faith. It is what we do most often when we come together. As a priest I have celebrated Mass somewhere around 11,700 times in 32 years. Then, add to that daily reception of the Body and Blood of Jesus during six years of seminary and weekly Communion through high school.

I continue to pray that the Body and Blood of Jesus courses through MY body and blood more and more each day. When I speak, I pray it is Christ speaking. When I am silent, I want it to be because that is exactly what Christ wants. To let Jesus Christ be the source and summit of my life needs to be my goal...so when I see him face to face at the gates of Heaven, we will recognize each other!

Pope Francis said of the Eucharist:

The Eucharist, although it is the fullness of sacramental life, is not a prize for the perfect but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak.

How very true. It fits with what the Pope has earlier said about the mission/ purpose of the Church: The church is not a museum of saints, but a hospital for sinners.





#### ON ABORTION (CONTINUED):

What does the <u>Catechism of the Catholic Church</u> say? (2271): Since the first century the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion. This teaching has not changed and remains unchangeable. Direct abortion, that is to say, abortion willed either as an end or a means, is gravely contrary to the moral law:

You shall not kill the embryo by abortion and shall not cause the newborn to perish. [Didache 2, 2: Sch 248, 148; cf. Ep. Barnabae 19, 5: PG 2, 777; Ad Diognetum 5, 6: PG 2, 1173; Tertullian, Apol. 9: PL 1, 319-320.]

God, the Lord of life, has entrusted to men the noble mission of safeguarding life, and men must carry it out in a manner worthy of themselves. Life must be protected with the utmost care from the moment of conception: abortion and infanticide are abominable crimes. [GS 51 S 3.]






