Happy Epiphany, Everyone! It's a great day for us to continue rejoicing in the coming of Jesus! The word "epiphany" means "manifestation." The Gospel passage we read this weekend recalls the manifestation of Jesus as the Messiah. Somehow the Magi were able to identify Jesus as the Messiah when hardly anyone in Israel recognized his importance. They saw the star that announced his birth and immediately set out to bring him the finest of gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. These gifts also represent who Jesus is: the gold points to his royalty as the divine king; the frankincense points to his priesthood; and the myrrh points ahead to his death when he will be anointed with lovely-smelling oil. We, too, are given the opportunity to offer the Lord a gift in honor of his divine identity. Remember the Christmas song, *Little Drummer Boy*? The drummer boy wants to give a gift that will honor the newborn king, but he has nothing to offer. So, he plays his drum as best as he can for the baby Jesus. As I listen to this song, I'm struck by his desire to give a gift that honors Jesus. I ask myself whether I am living my life in such a way that honors Him. If this is the case, what a beautiful offering for the Lord!

The month of January is traditionally dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus (celebrated on the 3rd). St. Paul says, *"At the name of Jesus every knee shall bend, those in Heaven, on the earth, and under the earth"* (Philippians 2:10). This name is the sweetest of all names and is one that we ought to call upon when we are feeling tempted to sin or are in despair, distress, sorrow, etc. His name is so sweet and powerful that it does what it means: God saves. A great prayer that we can practice reciting is simply called *The Jesus Prayer*: *"Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner."* There is a tradition of reciting this prayer 100 times in a row, allowing oneself to get lost in meditation on the name of Jesus. Some people follow the practice of reciting this prayer at the beginning of each hour to bring to mind our Savior, who is worthy of our adoration and praise. There are many ways for us to practice and increase our devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus. Let the Name of Jesus always be found in our speech.

We have a number of wonderful saints to be inspired by this month. Celebrating the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God (1st) was a beautiful way for us to begin the year. January 1<sup>st</sup> is also the Octave day (eighth day) of Christmas. Celebrating a major feast day for eight days is a very Catholic thing - we do the same for Easter. Looking at some of our saints, we have an American-born saint in Elizabeth Ann Seton (4th); an American bishop in John Neumann (5th); the father of monks in Anthony of the Desert (17th); a young girl who refused to offer incense to the pagan gods in Agnes (21st); perhaps the greatest mind the Church has ever known in Thomas Aquinas (28th); one of the greatest spiritual directors in Francis de Sales (24th); and a priest who started a religious order in honor of Francis de Sales in John Bosco (31st). We also celebrate the most important conversion in the history of Christianity on the 25th when we recall the conversion of St. Paul, followed by the honoring of two of his companions, Sts. Timothy and Titus, on the 26th. Also, we remember that January 22nd is an annual Day of Prayer and Fasting for the Unborn. Let us pray for an end to abortion in our country and around the world. May the Lord give you his peace!

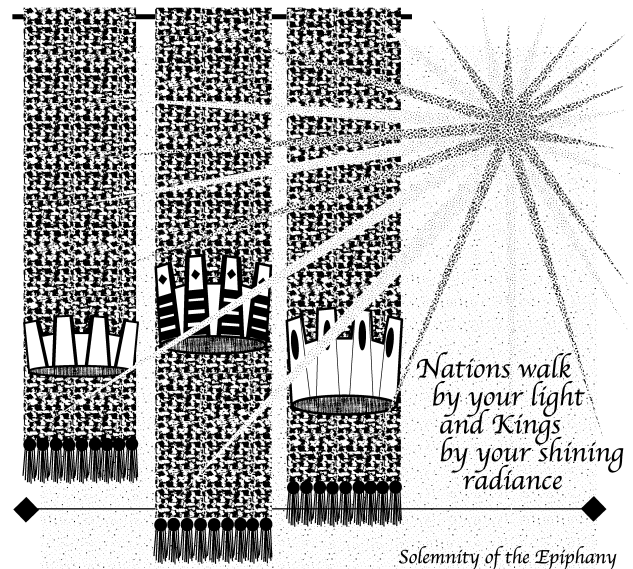
