When I first arrived in Bemidji and learned that I would be writing bulletin articles for each first Sunday of the month, I had to figure out what to do. Sometimes the most stressful part of writing or speaking about something is coming up with the topic to present — obviously I never have an issue with making the presentation long enough. Anyway, I loved the idea of writing about each month's traditional dedication and the saints we remember during each month. It's been fruitful for me, and I hope it has been for you as well. This is the twelfth time I'm doing this, though, and it seems poor form to simply duplicate those articles throughout the next year. So I'll be back to the starting point next month. If you have any topics you'd like to read about, let me know - I need about twelve of them. I can't promise every topic brought up will end up in these bulletin articles, but it would be great to know what you want to read about. Lastly, before I get into the month of July, some have asked whether I have recorded homilies - the answer is yes. Many times both Fr. Chuck's and my homilies are uploaded on our parish website, but I also upload them to soundcloud.com/evangelicaldisciple (Fr. Craig Vasek also puts his homilies on the same profile). Alright, now into the month of July.

This month is traditionally dedicated to the **Precious Blood of Jesus.** It is the blood of Jesus, the Lamb of God, that cleanses us of sin and protects us from the angel of death. Just as the blood of the Passover Lamb protected the Israelites from the angel of death in Egypt, so now the Blood of Jesus, the new Passover, protects us. What a powerful gift from our Father who provides everything we need! In the book of Revelation, we see an image of the saints in Heaven: *They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb'* (Rev 7:14). Take some time in your personal prayer to ask Jesus to give you an image of his Blood being poured over your soul, making it pure and ready for Heaven.

We've got some great saints to remember this month. To highlight just a few, this past Wednesday (3rd) we had one of the apostles, St. Thomas, and another apostle in St. James (25th), two members of the apostolic foundation of the Church; Mary Magdalene (22nd) shows us a great example of the radical conversion brought by Jesus after he cast seven demons out of her and then allowed her to be the first to see his resurrected body; Maria Goretti (6th) resisted the man who wanted to force himself upon her and then forgave him before she died by his hands; we have five founders of religious communities in Anthony Mary of Zaccaria (5th), Benedict (11th), Camillus de Lellis (14th), Bridget (23rd), and Ignatius of Loyola (31st); a couple great Franciscans in Bonaventure (15th) and Solanus Casey (30th - he was American!); and the grandparents of Mary, Joachim and Anne (26th). There are more great ones, but I'm all of out of room. There is so much inspiration in studying the lives of the saints! Let's keep learning and imitating them as they imitated Christ.

May the Lord give you his peace!


