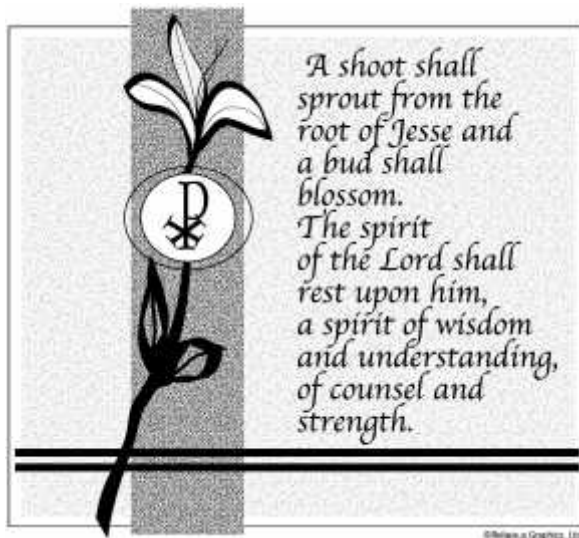

## Prepare In Joyful Hope

**Advent** marks the beginning of the Church's liturgical year, the four weeks of before Christmas (in Latin it means, *the coming*). The sights and sounds of Advent tell us Christ is coming. The season sharpens our sense of the world's need for a savior, and of the great mystery of God's becoming human for us, the incarnation.

Advent is an opportunity to shed the temporary world around us and prepare our minds and hearts for the coming of Christ. We celebrate the three comings of Christ: His birth in the past, his mysterious coming through his Church and the sacraments, and his promised return as our Judge at the end of time.

This is the time to wrestle with the mystery of God coming to earth so we can live with him forever. This season reminds us that we are playing the long game, not living for this world, but getting ready for the next.

The Church adorns itself with purple, symbolizing repentance and joyful expectation. Church decorations are more simple, representing the austerity of our time of waiting. An Advent wreath will be placed near the ambo, and the four candles are symbols of Christ as the Light of the World who overcomes the darkness.

## During Christmas Season

As you prepare for Christmas, please pray for those who are traveling or those who may not be familiar faces. Please welcome them. Make room for them and say hello. We all are disciples celebrating the birth of Christ.

Liturgical ministers, we know you have individual plans to make, but please sign up for Masses as early as possible, so we can best prepare for the larger crowds. Call the Parish Office 218-444-4262 or sign up online.

## Celebrate at Home

At home, celebrate with your own Advent wreath, lighting the candles before meals or before bed time. Replace screen and phone time with shared activity. Perhaps your family can make a special effort to help out the less fortunate either by helping at the Clothing Depot, Food Shelf, Giving Tree, or Tubs of Love. These purposeful activities provide a counterpoint to the most hectic and consumeristic time of the year.

Take advantage of the many resources offered online through FORMED (add sign up instructions) or use a different app or book to help you focus on prayer. Consider getting up a few minutes early to spend a few minutes of silence in God's presence. Be sure to attend our "Day of Grace" December 13. Priests will be available **7 a.m. to 7 p.m.** to hear individual confessions.

Do you bear good fruit for Christ? Or, do you spend your time, talent, and treasure constantly acquiring more toys, clutter, and junk. Our time, our talent, and our treasure are gifts that God has given us. What we do with them is our gift back to God. What gifts are you planning to give to the Lord during this upcoming Christmas season?

### Grieving Resource Library

If you have lost a loved one, maybe you have felt one of the following during your grief: *"It can't be, it just can't be; I never knew that it would hurt so much; part of my heart has been ripped away; no one ever told me that grief felt so much like fear; no one knows the tears still inside me; and finally, death leaves a heartache no one can heal, love leaves a memory no one can steal."*

Where do I find help? At St. Philip's. We have started to develop a Grieving Resource Library. We currently have 30-some books and pamphlets that could help you through your grief of the loss of a loved one.

Some of the books we carry are:

- **Too Soon A Memory**, a guide for parents suffering a miscarriage. This booklet focuses on the needs of parents who have to deal with a loss that involved tangible memories.
- **Journey Through Grief**, a series of four books: Book one, *A Time to Grieve*, the three N's, normal, natural, necessary. Book two, *Experiencing Grief*, when your loss sinks in, accepting your grief, secondary losses. Book three, *Finding Hope and Healing*, how much longer God? How long does this last? Book Four, *Rebuilding and Remembering*, permission to grieve – again, the first anniversary, rebuilding your life, continuing bonds.
- **Getting Past Christmas**, tips for surviving December after the death of a loved one.
- **When Bad Things Happen to Good People**, how to cope with hard times and personal pain after the loss of a loved one.
- **The Gift of a Memory**, a warm and gentle gift of love that commemorates the loss of a special life and celebrates our most cherished memories.

The books/pamphlets are located in the St. Kateri Room and can be checked out for 2 weeks or more if you need to. If you are not sure which book could assist you, contact either Fr. Chuck, Fr. Bryan, Deacon Kermit or Deacon Robb. *"The journey of grieving takes you from loving in the presence to loving in the absence."*
