Christ Comes to Make His Dream for Our Lives Come True *December 15, 2019*

At this weekend's Masses, the color of our vestments have changed again. They changed from green to purple at the beginning of Advent; from purple to white for the Immaculate Conception; back to purple, and now rose!

⌋ This change of colors is a visual symbol that Christmas is drawing ever closer.

- Just like when the sun is coming up in the very early morning, and the dark night sky begins to glow with a pale, rose-colored light, so the color of our vestments change from dark to light.

And, at the same time our vestments change color, the color of all of our hearts should also be changing.

⌋ For the first weeks of Advent, we've prayed about: our need for God; our sinfulness; our helplessness in achieving life's meaning and fulfillment that we long for.

- Today we change direction a bit. While we don't forget about *our need* for the Savior, we focus our attention more on *our Savior Himself*.

Christ came on the first Christmas in order to make His dream for a broken and fallen world come true. This Christmas, He wants to come into our hearts again for the same reason ... to make His dream for each of our lives come true.

When Jesus came to earth, He met the blind, and gave them sight; the poor, and gave them hope; the crippled, and gave them the strength to walk.

He's started the same work in us ... and He's eager to keep working.

⌋ We often find ourselves in the darkness of our own ignorance and selfishness. Jesus offers us light in the teachings of His Church.

⌋ We're lacking in our virtues, but He fills us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

- We're weak ... not able to pray as we should; to bear witness to others as we should; to love others as we should. Our Lord heals and strengthens us by feeding and maintaining us with his very body, blood and divinity in the Eucharist.

Let's ask Jesus to give us the courage to reach out from the comfort of our faith into the darkness of a life that lacks faith ... just as He left heaven to come to earth.

Christ has a dream for each one of our lives ... Salvation. He's coming to make that dream come true. That's what He wants for Christmas, and it's within our power to give it to Him. Let us make our hearts like little mangers, ready to receive the newborn Savior when He comes.

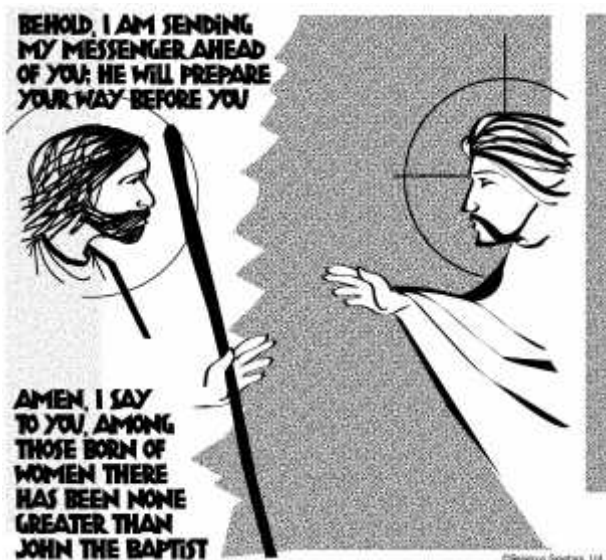
