### Blessed Are We Who Are Called to the Supper of the Lamb

In this weekend's Gospel, we hear John the Baptist clarifying what he meant when he told the priests and Levites, "but there is one among you whom you do not recognize," (*John 1:26*). Then, the next thing you know, the very next day, Jesus Himself walks up to John the Baptist, and John cries out in recognition, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (*John 1:29*).

As we ponder this term "Lamb of God", which we hear over and over again at Mass, it may seem strange to us. Yet, it's perhaps the most fitting description. Jewish life for many centuries embraced rituals of sacrifice to God - offerings, gifts of love - to please God.

What terminology would we use if Jesus came today? "Here comes Jesus Christ Superstar!" or, "Here is that guy whose words have gone viral?" Hmmm. Somehow, those substitutes don't seem to fit. We need to go back to Old Testament times in order to better understand and appreciate the term "Lamb of God" and how it became so appropriate to our Catholic faith.

We remember the sacrifice Abraham was asked to make of his only beloved son, Isaac. This was heading toward being a sad scene that instead, turns into a joyous one, when Abraham's sacrifice of Isaac was halted by an angel. "Abraham looked up and saw a single ram caught by its horns in the thicket. So, Abraham went and took the ram and offered it up as a burnt offering in place of his son." (*Genesis 22:13*).

The lamb is also central to the Passover story as God passed through the land of Egypt, striking down the firstborn of each household. Yet, the homes of the Jews who marked their doors with the blood of a lamb are "passed over." In the Book of Revelation, the term "lamb" is used 29 times, always referring to Christ, whose blood saves the "new Israel" from sin and death. Each time we receive Christ in Communion, we hear, "This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."

The sacrifice made by the Lamb of God was a *perfect* sacrifice. The sacrifices *we* make as Christians, as sheep of the Good Shepherd (*and if genuine*) will be perfectly acceptable to God. We're asked to be in communion with the Lamb, in our sacrifices as well as at a meal. And, for sure, to be a Christian, many sacrifices are expected of us. Yet, mostly we're asked to stay faithful, knowing that, as St. Paul said, "He has now reconciled in his fleshly body and through His death, to present you holy, without blemish, and irreproachable before Him." (*Colossians 1:22*). Our beloved St. John Paul II spoke about this required sacrifice, saying, "To believe in Jesus today demands a new martyrdom . . . to go against the tide . . . to follow the Lamb wherever He goes." The Lamb is with us, and we know the Lamb is the Lamb of God.

So, as we hear "Behold, the Lamb of God!", and receive the martyred Lamb in the Eucharist at Mass, even though we assert we're not worthy to enter under His roof, we are blessed, "we, who are called to the supper of the Lamb."



### JT. PHILIP'S SCHOOL HAPPENINGS






