Happy Third Sunday of Easter

April 26, 2020

Our Gospel reading this week is one of my favorite stories from scripture. The story of Jesus joining the two disciples as they are walking to Emmaus, and breaking open for them the Scriptures, and how they all related to him. I have often imagined what it would have been like to walk with Jesus on that road and hear him explain each prophecy. And then, along with the two disciples, recognize him in the breaking of the bread. "Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?" Even though it was evening, they set out at once and returned to Jerusalem to tell the eleven what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread.

Do our hearts burn within us as we hear the stories of his resurrection? Our hearts should be burning, and our faces should be glowing. He is risen, he is truly risen! Be proud to profess it!
