## Fun Catholic Facts from the desk of Fr. Michael

August 2, 2020

The Pope is protected by the Swiss Papal Guard. Wearing uniforms designed by Michelangelo and commonly armed with halberds (spear/battle axe), they are capable of using heavier weapons if needed. Each member is Catholic, male, and Swiss, and must complete military training in Switzerland. They must demonstrate good conduct and be at least five-foot-eight in height. Those who are chosen are granted a private audience with the pope along with their families. In extreme circumstances, they are expected to guard the Holy Father with their lives. Although the Pontifical Swiss Guard's first duty is the service of the Pope, during periods of "sede vacante" (when the office of pope is vacant), the Swiss Guards instead protect the College of Cardinals, as they meet to elect a new Bishop of Rome. The Swiss Papal Guard is the oldest active military unit in continual existence since 1506.



When I was in Rome in 2019, our class of transitional deacons served Mass with Pope Francis during the feast of The Epiphany Of Our Lord at St. Peter's Basilica. As we entered the gates wearing our clerical collars we were saluted by the Swiss Papal Guards because as ordained ministers of the Catholic Church, we are known as members of the Papal Army. It was a wonderful experience and I must say aside from the language barrier, we felt right at home.

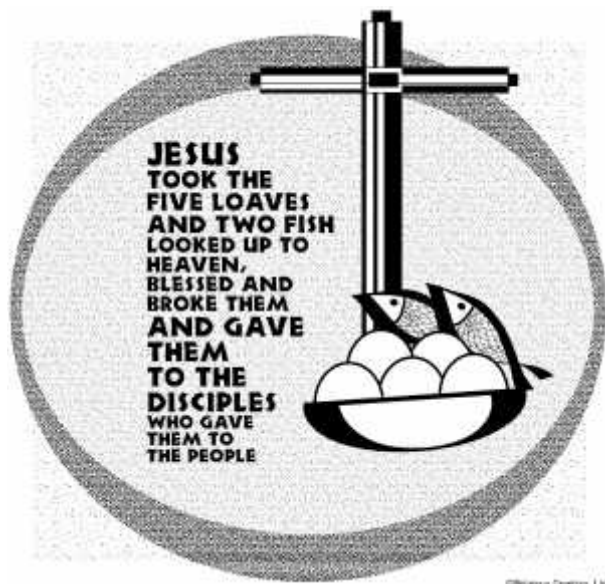

July 1, 2020 starts the new year for safe environment. **Safe Environment Certification** is necessary for every adult (age 18 or over) clergy, visiting clergy, employee, independent contractor, and volunteer in the Diocese of Crookston who has the potential for contact with children or vulnerable adults.

This year's safe environment module focuses on recognizing abuse and the recommended technology guidelines. Appendix B – Recommended Technology Guidelines for Pastoral Work with Young People can be found in its entirety here <https://www.crookston.org/offices/safeenvironment/codeofconduct/appendix-b/file>

The module is **NOT** compatible with cell phones or iPads and will **time out after 60 minutes for security reasons.**

## ST. PHILIP'S PARISH COMMUNITY PANDEMIC RESPONSE PLAN

Staff is drafting a Pandemic Response Plan to allow us to worship together and participate in other celebrations and activities while protecting the health of all who work, worship, study, volunteer or visit our campus. This plan will evolve as the Diocese of Crookston, public health officials and other government sources provide updated information. Our response will be fluid and based on our current situational analysis and will likely change frequently. Drafts will be posted at [stphilipsbemidji.org](http://stphilipsbemidji.org).

Please Note: Those over age 65 or otherwise vulnerable are strongly encouraged not to attend Mass or other campus events in person. In addition, anyone showing any symptoms of sickness, or anyone who has a household member who is sick or showing symptoms of sickness should not attend; this includes priests or other ministers who are sick or showing signs of sickness. Social distancing (six feet or more between all not sharing the same household) shall be maintained. Face coverings are required per state mandate.

**PUBLIC PROGRAMS** (Will remain open to public unless otherwise directed by Diocese of Crookston and/or government regulations)

**Masses (weekend)**

- Groups not to exceed 50% of church seating capacity or a maximum of 250 people.
- Bishops of Minnesota have removed the religious obligation to attend Mass on Sunday, Individuals may choose to attend daily Mass(es).
- Schedules: Sat (5:30 p.m.) and Sunday (7 a.m., 9 a.m., 11 a.m. and 6:30 p.m.)
- Saturday 5:30 p.m. Mass will be livestreamed (Accessible via [stphilipsbemidji.org](http://stphilipsbemidji.org), YouTube, Facebook). Recordings available during the week.
- Exterior doors will be unlocked/opened 30 minutes prior to Mass.
- Greeters welcome parishioners (from 6-ft. distance) and encourage all to use hand sanitizer and properly position masks, if necessary. (People should be made aware of State of Minnesota Mask Mandate) but should not be challenged.)
- Ushers (when available) will seat people or direct them to seats that maximize the number of people in the church and Social Hall.
- Seating will be reserved to every third pew. People who do not live in the same household will space six feet from others.
- Video and sound from sanctuary will be available in Social Hall.
- There is to be no congregational singing. Singing by a single cantor is allowed at a distance of at least 12 feet from others. Worship aids are available near entrances. Dispose of worship aids in wastebaskets after Mass.

There will be no offertory collection and procession. Offertory gifts are appreciated and can be given through several channels.

- ♦ Deposit envelopes in boxes in the Narthex.
- ♦ Contact Deacon Kermit Erickson to set up recurring ACH withdrawals.
- ♦ Give online at [stphilipsbemidji.org](http://stphilipsbemidji.org).
- ♦ Give via text: Text "give" to 218-277-6444, follow link you receive, receive a link, click "sign in" to register for an account, complete registration to receive a secure PIN, select "offertory," enter the donation amount and payment, tap "save payment" to save it for future gifts.

**Masses (weekday)**

- ♦ Weekday Mass schedule (Monday 8:30 a.m., Tuesday 6:30 p.m., Wednesday 8:30 a.m., Thursday 7 a.m. and Friday 8:30 a.m.)
  - ♦ Exterior doors will open 30 minutes prior to Mass times.
  - ♦ Attendees may enter the building (maintain social distancing) but should not enter the sanctuary until staff open the doors to signify sanitation is complete.
  - ♦ Procedures same as above for weekend Masses.
- A sufficient quantity of hosts should be consecrated at the Mass but placed on a corporal on the side of the altar to allow the priest to consecrate the main host without breathing on the hosts for the faithful.
  - Attendees will remain in their places for Holy Communion. Clergy and ministers will move through church to distribute the Body of Christ.
  - Attendees should leave masks in place until after they receive communion (in the hand is HIGHLY recommended) and the person distributing has moved six feet away. Attendees consume Jesus and replace masks.
  - Ministers should sanitize their hands before and after distributing Holy Communion and carry a sanitizing wipe with them as they distribute.
  - Ushers open side doors and direct people to exit promptly without grouping too close together
  - Facilities staff and volunteers will sanitize church, entryways and restrooms in accordance with CDC recommendations <https://bit.ly/2yHXpq2>.
  - Bulletins are available in the Narthex or online
  - The Chapel will be closed on weekends to minimize areas that require sanitization.
  - Holy water fonts are empty, and hymnals have been removed from pews.
  - Parents should speak to their children before coming to Mass to let them know things will be different and they must maintain distance. (Children younger than two do not need masks.)
  - Church leadership may cancel gatherings, if necessary.
