## The 32<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

November 8, 2020

Be prepared, for you know neither the day nor the hour.

As our liturgical year nears the end, our scripture readings concentrate on the end of times, on the long, expected return of Jesus.

In our Gospel reading from Matthew this Sunday Jesus tells the story of the ten virgins, five of whom were wise and brought extra oil and five who were not so wise and brought only their lamps with no extra oil. The bridegroom came later than expected and the five who were prepared were admitted to the banquet. The five virgins who were not prepared, who had to hurry off to purchase oil for their lamps, missed out, and the door was locked before their return. We need to be prepared, live our lives as if Christ was returning today or if we were to die suddenly today. There are those who think, I can live as I want today and there will always be time to reconcile with God later. The reward will be the same, right. However, we may not have the opportunity for a last second repentance or death bed conversion. It does not make any sense to wait!

As we heard the past couple of weeks, God loves us and wants us to love him and love our neighbor. He wants us to live our life, loving each other and helping each other. If we help each other have good healthy, happy and holy lives here on earth and help bring those around us into a good relationship with our Lord, then as our second reading from Thessalonians says, for if we believe that Jesus died and rose, so too will God, through Jesus, bring with him those who have fallen asleep.

I pray that all of you are staying safe and smart during this time of pandemic. Keep wearing those masks anytime you are in public, stay six feet apart when possible and wash any possible germs away often. Even if you are young and in great health, we all want to make sure we protect those around us from the virus. Don't become virus weary.






