News from our school ~

January 31, 2021

We are excited to be celebrating Catholic Schools Week this week at St. Philip's Catholic School. (See details inside!) We are so grateful for all the support and prayers that you have provided us – especially this year. Without all of you and your involvement in our school we wouldn't be able to continue offering an excellent Catholic education to our students—fulltime and in-person. We receive support in so many forms—from helping out in our lunchroom, praying the rosary for the school on Wednesday mornings, donating items, and financial contributions. St. Philip's Parish is an integrated part of our school community and for that we are so thankful.

We are especially grateful to all who prayed for and financially supported the *Faith in Our Future* campaign. We thank all those who have completed their pledges and those who continue to honor their pledges. Funds collected pay the costs incurred with the project. We are thankful for the generosity, stewardship and providence that made the *Faith in Our Future* campaign possible. We had space needs but had no way to know that challenges a pandemic would bring.

In addition, we thank those whose endowed funds (see below) help make it possible to provide tuition assistance and pay competitive teacher salaries. For 2020-21 approximately \$90,000 was used to help families striving to provide a rigorous Catholic education for their children. St. Philip's endowed funds have a principle value near \$1 million. These funds earn interest that will help provide access to education at St. Philip's Catholic School in perpetuity.

In order to introduce families not currently enrolled at St. Philip's School to this important part of our parish mission, we are hosting school information night on Thursday, February 4, 2021 beginning at 6 PM. If you are interested in attending, please contact the school office for a reservation at 218-444-4938.

One change that will be in effect starting next week is that school Masses will be celebrated on Wednesdays only. All of the students will be attending together at 8:40 Wednesday mornings. Friday mornings will be more "parishioner-friendly", especially during this time of Covid19.

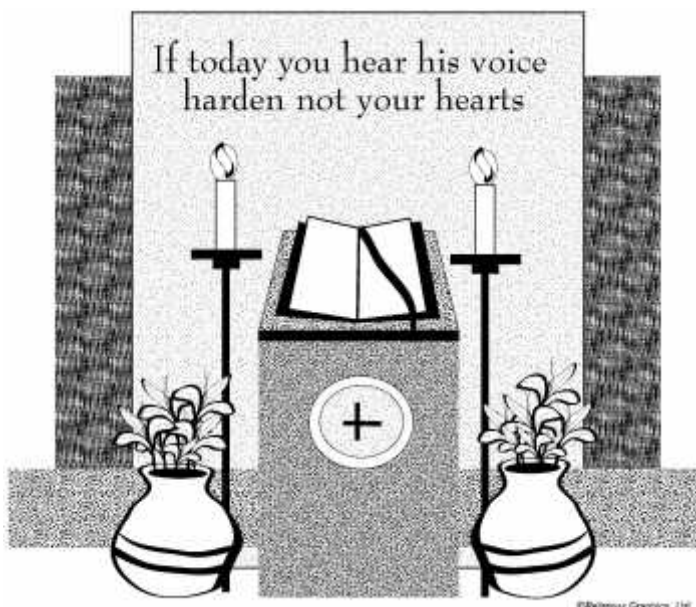



3. Log in to the account you created.
4. Click . In the **Quick Links** section, select the **My Own Church** link.
5. Select the **My Offering** tab.
6. Click  to display the **Giving History** page.
7. In the **Filter Options** section, select filters to narrow down the transactions you want to include in the statement:
 - A. **Funds:** to view giving to a specific fund, select the fund from the list. Or, select **All** to include all funds.
 - B. **Years:** to view annual contributions for a specific year, select the year from the list.
 - C. **Tax Deductible:** select the checkbox to include tax-deductible contributions only.
 - D. **Include Member Information:** select the checkbox to include individual family member's giving information.
8. Click . Select the **Statement** link.
9. The **Save** dialog box opens.
10. Open the file or save it to your computer.
11. If desired, print the statement.

My Own Church

St. Philip's is introducing a new system called "My Own Church." It allows you to manage your family in-

To create your My Own Church Account:

1. Go to stphilipsbemidji.org
2. Click on the My Own Church Button (It will appear in the banner images or scroll down the page.)
3. Click "New User"
4. Scroll down to select "St. Philip's, Bemidji" in the "Organization" field
5. Create a "User Name."
6. Create an account. (Accounts need to be verified by church staff, so you will not have immediate access. Accounts should be approved within one business day.) Please note, the system will attempt to match the email you input to an existing account. We may have an old email. You can update all contact information when you access your account.
7. After your account is approved, you will have access to your family's information!

Check out My Own Church soon to download your 2020 Year-End Giving Contribution Statement. (We will mail statements by January 31 for families that have not accessed statements online.)
