

The Fourth Sunday of Easter:

I listen to a lot of Christian contemporary music and one of my favorite songs is a song by Ray Boltz that I believe fits very well with the message of this weeks Gospel. 


Come by to browse these beautiful items after all Masses on May 8/9 and maybe take home a piece of the Holy Land.


