The Fourth Sunday of Easter:

April 25, 2021

I listen to a lot of Christian contemporary music and one of my favorite songs is a song by Ray Boltz that I believe fits very well with the message of this week's Gospel. The lyrics of the song really lay out what it means that Jesus is our Good Shepherd. How he is our protector, our guide and our helper whenever we need him. Here are the lyrics:

"I was climbing up a mountain, headed for the top, my feet started sliding and I almost fell off. I landed on a rocky ledge, suspended in the air, and I cried out in despair. Is there anybody out there, anybody there at all. Then I saw him reaching down and I heard him call.

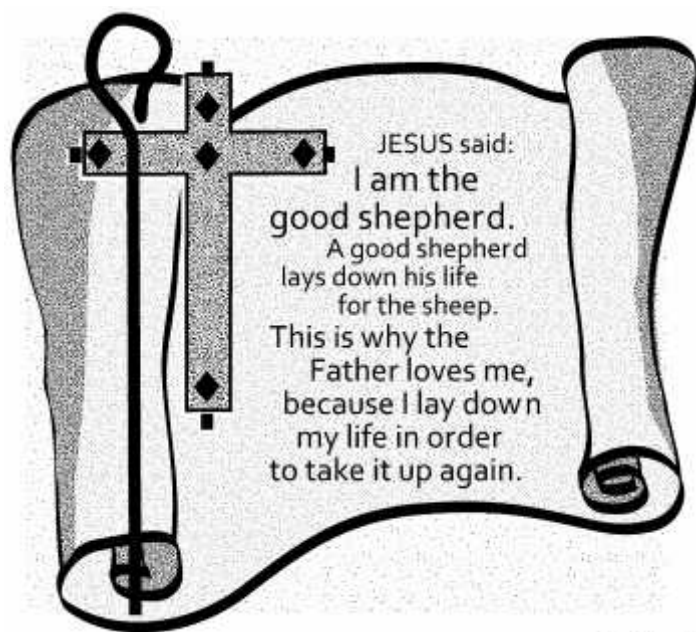

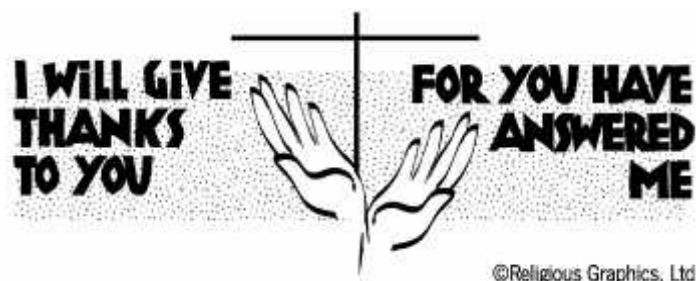

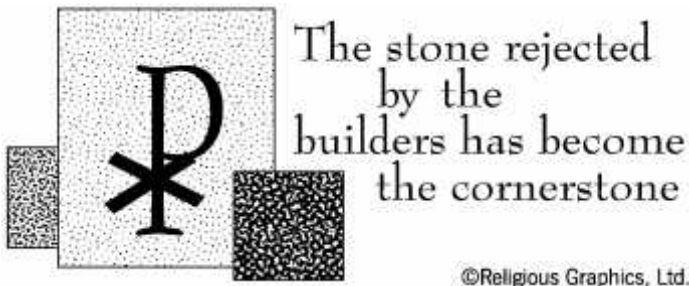
Come by to browse these beautiful items after all Masses on May 8/9 and maybe take home a piece of the Holy Land.

Bookkeeping/Accounting Position Opening

The Parish Bookkeeper is responsible for implementing and performing all financial and personnel recording keeping for St. Philip's Church of Bemidji, along with St. Charles of Pennington and the Holy Spirit Newman Center. This includes all A/R, A/P, general ledger, payroll, bank reconciliations, journal entries, month end and year end reporting. Accurate records must be maintained for several departments. These include the administration, school, faith formation, hot lunch, cemetery, clothing depot, building projects and investments. The bookkeeper also plays a vital role in budgeting and serves as a vital resource to the pastor.

Some post high school accounting/bookkeeping education and/or experience is required. A college degree is not necessary but would be helpful. Salary offer will depend upon education and/or experience. Position is full time and benefits are included. We are currently looking for a June 1 start date as current bookkeeper plans to retire June 30.
