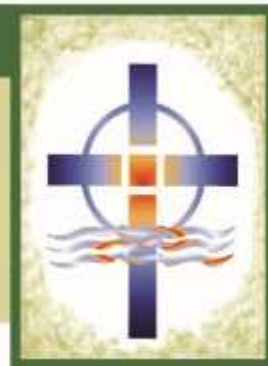

As some of you already know, my health is challenged. With my right foot already amputated, they are slowly "chiseling" away at the left foot. It is not good. I fight to keep it; I suspect before long I will lose it. I told them just to make sure they make both legs even, so that I can walk into heaven on judgement day. My kidneys have also been compromised.

When Bishop Pates came to crack down as our interim Bishop, he must have noticed my trouble getting around. Because of the situation with my health, he asked me to resign as Pastor of St. Philip's, the Newman Center, and St. Charles in Pennington. I remain as Pastor of Red Lake and Wilton. At first it was difficult to do what Bishop Pates asked; I've always had trouble bowing to authority. But on the day I was ordained I promised the Bishop and his successors "obedience." At first I did what he asked out of obedience. But God has His ways of working on you and I now realize it is in the best interest of all concerned.

I love being a Pastor and over the years I have discovered that the secret of being a good Pastor is to love the people you are called to Pastor. The last year for me was a taste of heaven; tears still come to my eyes as I remember last year's Easter Vigil. I will miss everything about Bemidji. As a young priest I was a first love; you never forget your first love. I believe a Pastor comes to a parish when he is needed but not necessarily welcomed; its time to go when he is wanted but no longer needed!

Bishop Pates has made a marvelous choice for the next Pastor of St. Philip's. Father Bill DeCrans, presently Pastor of Ada, will become your new Pastor on July 1, 2021. I know Father as a marvelous priest and he will serve you well. I pray you will welcome him and care for him as well as he will care for you! With your marvelous Parish and School Staffs, Bemidji will be blessed. You deserve only the best!!!!

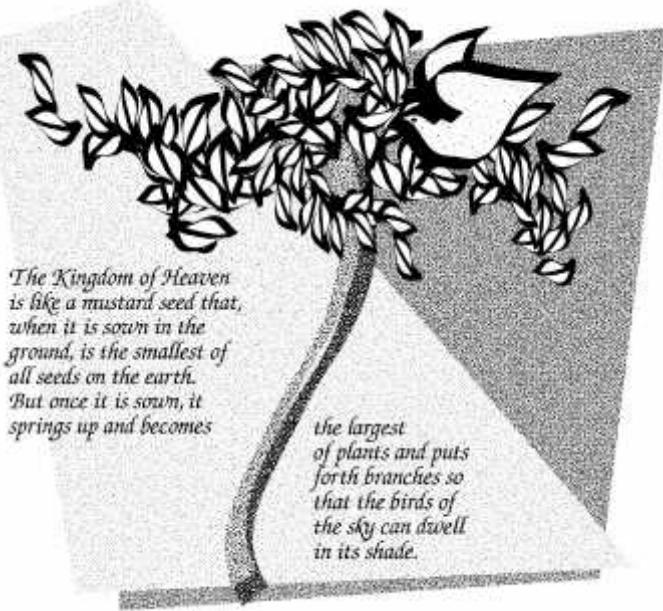
Congratulations! Please contact the Parish Office as soon as possible (six months or more in advance) so that we can work with you to prepare for the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony.

Dispensation to be lifted July 1

The Diocese of Crookston will join the other five Minnesota dioceses in re-instating the Sunday obligation to attend Mass on July 1 and thus will be effective the weekend of July 3 and 4.

The decision is made in line with the guidance of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Minnesota Department of Health. Especially noteworthy is that as of June 1, the percentage of adults vaccinated in the state of Minnesota was 65%. Heartfelt thanks are to be expressed to those who have taken this step. Because of vaccination, the country has experienced a significant decline in the incidence of COVID-19.
