## *The Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

June 27, 2021

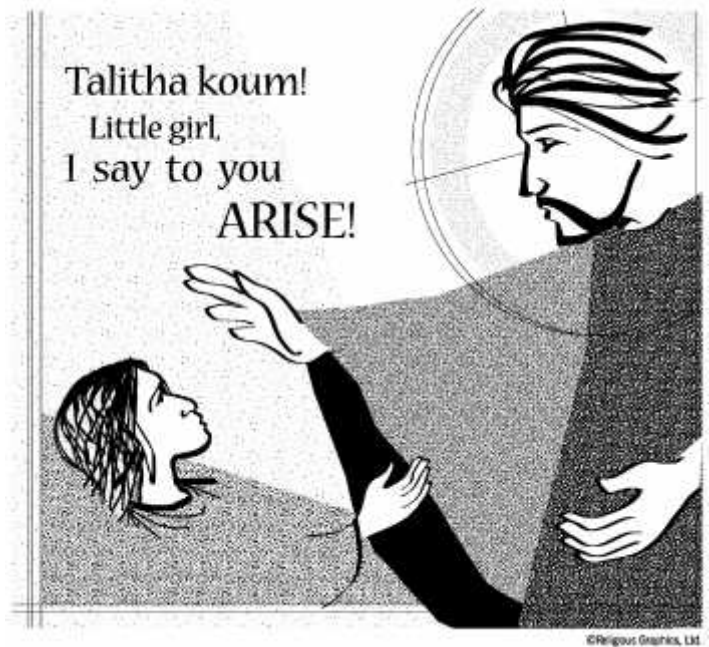
