## *The Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

What must I do to inherit eternal life?

This is the question that the rich man in our Gospel reading today asks of Jesus. How does Jesus respond? "You know the commandments: You shall not kill, you shall not commit adultery, you shall not steal, you shall not bear false witness, you shall not defraud, and honor your father and mother."

In addition to observing these, Jesus told him to go, sell what you have and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven, then come and follow me.

Sometimes in our lives we put too much effort and thought into our financial well being and not enough into our spiritual or eternal well being. It is definitely important to make sure we provide for our family's earthly needs of food, medical care and shelter. But it is also important to live a Christian life by sharing from our goods, not just from our excess, with those who are in need. If we share from our resources, from our talents, our time and financial, we will have treasure in heaven. God will bless us in this life and has promised eternal life in the age to come.

May we be able to say, as the rich man in the Gospel, "Teacher, all these I have observed from my youth," but may we also be able to say that we have truly followed Jesus and his example.
