Happy Fifth Sunday of Easter,

May 15, 2022

It is very exciting to celebrate all of the things happening in our parish and in our Diocese of Crookston during this Easter season and beyond. It is wonderful when the Sacraments are being celebrated as God's grace is being poured out in abundance upon our whole faith community.

This past weekend we celebrated with 45 of our young children who received Jesus for the first time in the Holy Eucharist! Next Sunday May 22 we have 19 youth who are to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. Also, during the Easter season we have 17 children who have or will soon celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism.

In addition, we also have exciting celebrations happening in our diocese. On May 21st, John Wilebski III will be ordained a Transitional Deacon and on June 11th, four men, Brent Hoffner, Jeffrey Reese, Trevor Pikula and Robert Thom will be ordained as Permanent Deacons. May God's grace flow upon each of these men and help them in their ministry of service to their parishes and our Diocese of Crookston. This brings back memories for me of my own ordination. It is hard to believe that it has been nine years since I received God's grace through this Sacrament.

Please continue to pray for young men of our parish to be open to the possibility of the priesthood, as well as for men 35 and up to be open to answering God's call to the Deaconate. If you are a male member of our parish between the ages of 30 and 55, and you feel that you should be giving more back to God for all that he has done for you, please pray about the possibility that God may be calling you to consider becoming a Deacon!!! It is very rewarding!

Just like the early disciples in our first reading this week, God has a great plan for the salvation of the world, but he needs us to cooperate with the plan and share the "Good news" with others! Whether we are ordained or not, we are called through our baptism to share in Christ's mission.

As Jesus says in our Gospel this week, "I give you a new commandment: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how you will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."






