We are privileged here at St. Philip's that while we are in this prayerful season of Lent, a day has been set aside on March 17 as a **DAY OF GRACE**. In the secular world we are used to terms like period of grace, week of grace or a month of grace. Normally these terms refer to a set length of time after the due date which payment may be made without penalty. Here the key word is *penalty*. There is an element of being forgiven. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Grace is favor, the free and undeserved help that God gives us to respond to his call to become children of God, adoptive sons and daughters, partakers of the divine nature and eternal life. (CCC.1996). I know most of us are familiar with what we call an Hour of Grace, but the understanding is the same when we talk of the Day of Grace. It is basically a day dedicated to **PRAYER and PENANCE.** It is a day when many spiritual graces are granted. It is a day when most hardhearted sinners are touched and forgiven by the grace of God. The trick on the day of Grace is very simple—we just need to open our hearts and allow the Holy Spirit to guide us. We just need to make an effort to put all the distractions away and concentrate on our union with God. It is a precious moment for us. Let us just grab it.

As some of you might have already heard, I will be leaving for my vacation to Africa, Malawi, on April 16 and hope to be back on June 1. I am just excited about it. This is the longest I have been away from my relatives, friends and country both in terms of distance and duration. I have a lot of good stories and experiences to share with my relatives and friends back home. I know I will miss this great and vibrant community of St. Philip's for at least 6 weeks. As I have always said, this community is a community of faith-filled, jovial, supportive and accommodative people. Some of you have given me personal gifts as I travel home. I say **THANK YOU, THANK YOU and THANK YOU VERY MUCH.** 

I ask for your prayers for my safe trip to and from Malawi. I will, as well, remember you in my daily prayers. May God bless and protect you all!




