Greetings! For those who don't know me, I am Westin Gourneau, a seminarian studying for the Diocese of Crookston. I am excited to be back at my home parish this summer and live in the rectory to continue diving into the aspects of parish and community life.

The most common question I get is "What are your plans for this summer?" it's a great question and it's one that I would like to address because I think it is a great opportunity to inform the parish what seminary formation looks like today. My main plan for this summer is to grow closer to the Lord through engaging my formation goals in a parish and community setting.

In the seminary formation goals are structured around four main dimensions the human, spiritual, intellectual, and pastoral dimensions of priestly formation. These four dimensions are crucial to the development of a priestly heart, a development that I believe the Lord is trying to foster in my heart. I would like to share with you what formation goals look like so that you can get a better understanding of what my mission is here.

To start, human formation goals simply try to help encourage people to be more approachable humans. Some examples of what goals look like in human formation are: to engage in a healthy amount of exercise, wake up early, cooking, cleaning, good hygiene, and good manners. Although these goals are simple it is crucial to formation. Secondly, some examples of spiritual goals will be to attend Mass every day and to pray the Liturgy of the Hours, the prayer of the Church, as well as some time for personal and intercessional prayer. No one wants a priest who doesn't talk to Jesus, that is why the spiritual part of formation is the one that connects the other three and makes them one. Next, examples of intellectual goals can be as simple as reading the books the seminary assigned over the summer as well as some online theology courses to keep my brain engaged with the great intellectual tradition of the church. Lastly, pastoral goals focus on conforming one's heart to be a servant leader to God's people. This can be seen through participating in and leading small groups at the youth camps and events, helping with Masses at the nursing home, and participating in small groups at the church.

I hope this information helped you understand seminary formation a little better. There is still a lot of growth that needs to still be done in my heart and I'm excited that the Lord has granted me the opportunity to grow in this parish! I hope to see you around, feel free to have a conversation with me at any time if you have any more questions!

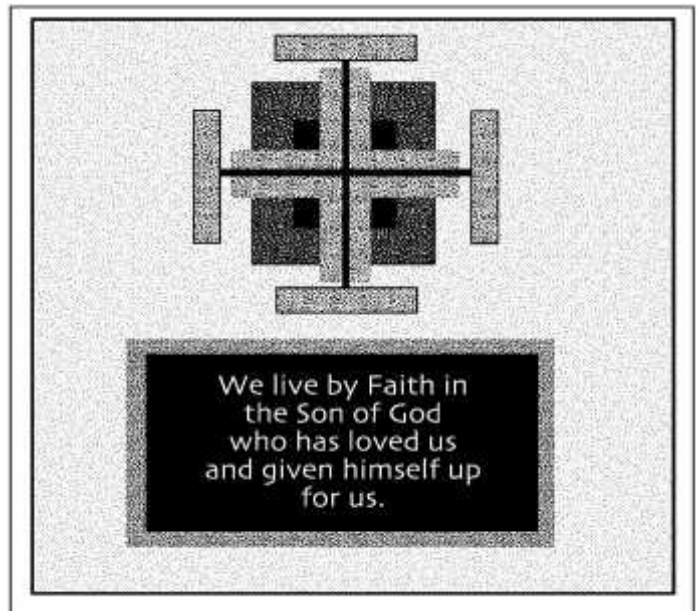
