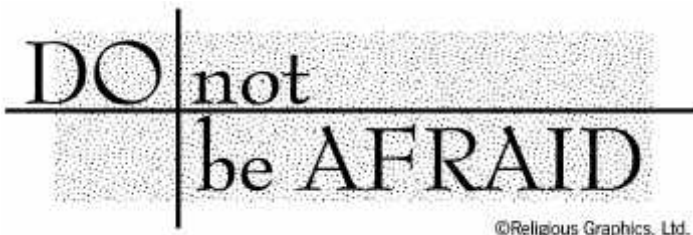

### Pro-Life Chairman Speaks to Dobbs Anniversary

Most Reverend Michael F. Burbidge, Chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities released a statement in early June in anticipation of the first anniversary of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*, which overturned *Roe v. Wade* on June 24, 2022. "Over the past year, while some states have acted to protect preborn children, others have tragically moved to enshrine abortion in law—enacting extreme policies that leave children vulnerable to abortion, even until the moment of birth...The work that lies ahead continues to be not just changing laws but also helping to change hearts, with steadfast faith in the power of God to do so," he said. "The task before us begins with the knowledge of the truth and our courage to *speak* it and to *live* it with compassion," he said, and stated that we are each called to "radical solidarity" with women facing an unexpected or challenging pregnancy and doing whatever we can to provide them with the care and support they need to welcome their children."

### "Discerning the Diaconate"

*Are you being called to be a permanent deacon? Do you know someone you can invite to discern the diaconate?* You may be reading this because you are interested in exploring the vocation of a permanent deacon. The next formation group will begin in the fall of 2024. From fall 2023 through winter 2024, the Diocese will host a number of "Discerning the Diaconate" sessions around the Diocese for men, and spouses if married, so that they can find out more about the program. If you wish to talk about the program before that time, you can email Dcn. Mark Krejci, Director of Deacon Personnel and Formation for the Diocese at [mkrejci@crookston.org](mailto:mkrejci@crookston.org) to arrange a phone or zoom call. You are also strongly encouraged to talk with your pastor as well as deacons you may already know. If you believe you know a man who should consider the diaconate, I encourage you to share this information with him. In a recent survey of Catholic deacons, they indicated that a parishioner's encouragement played a significant role in the deacon deciding to enter the formation program.
