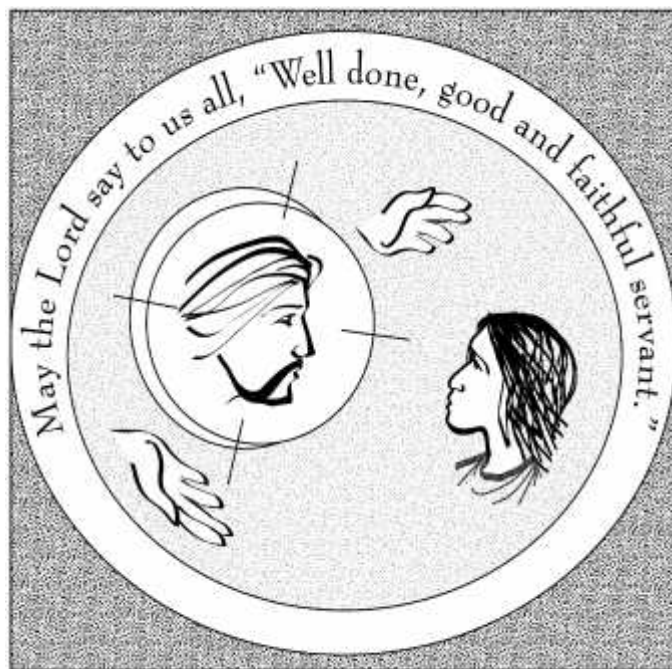

### Daycare and Preschool Building Ready to Occupy

St. Philip's purchased and began the remodeling project at 602 Beltrami Avenue several months ago with the goal of opening a daycare in half of the building and preschool rooms in the other half. We are happy to announce that the remodeling has been completed to the point of having been granted a Certificate of Occupancy. Now that this certificate has been granted, the daycare licensing department from the county/state are in their final stages of issuing the daycare license. By the time this bulletin is printed, that may have happened.

This has been a very ambitious project with stringent building codes that assure the safety of the children and staff. In order to meet those building codes, we needed to work with skilled tradespeople. Our parish can really be proud that many of those companies are owned by, and/or have employees who are members of St. Philip's. Their dedication to the job was great and their skills are so valuable. Those companies include: Frenzel Construction, Frontier Electric, Naylor Heating and Refrigeration, Bonded Lock and Key, Kelly's Plumbing, and ICON Architectural Group. Working with the City of Bemidji and the Fire Department on the permitting and inspection process went smoothly once we met each benchmark.

Coordinating all of the work for the project was provided by Larry Mack in a volunteer capacity. We cannot thank him enough. But Larry will be the first to say that the strong support and cooperation he got from Brad Arel through the whole process was crucial. With so many people involved, it gets impossible to name everyone else that made this successful. We thank them all!

We look forward to updating you in the very near future about the actual Daycare License and the opening of this wonderful program. The area surrounding Bemidji has had extreme needs for additional daycare slots, and it is very gratifying that St. Philip's could address some of those needs. It is good for our parishioners and staff needing daycare, good for our economy, and good for all the families that will use our services.

### DEFYING THE PRO-LIFE TREND

Among abortion practitioners, "independent physicians" saw a large jump in 2022, likely reflecting the growth of telemedicine abortions sent to women through the mail without in-person doctor's visits. More than 2,000 abortions were performed on non-Minnesota residents, which is about double the 2021 number. Yet the estimated abortion rate among Minnesota residents also rose—from 8.5 to 9.5. *Abortion Report from MCCL News, Vol. 53 No. 3, page 1; July-Sept. 2023*
