Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

This Sunday we light the pink candle of joy for Gaudete Sunday, the Sunday of rejoicing. "*Rejoice always*", Paul teaches in the second reading. Today we can because Christmas is almost here, but *rejoice always*? Is this even possible? Yes!

Isaiah is overjoyed because the Spirit of the Lord is upon him and sends him to do good works such as healing, and bringing the news of God's justification to His people. Isaiah knows the Lord is with him and has given him great work to do.

In the responsorial psalm, we're told Mary is full of joy because the Lord has looked upon her with favor and has done great things for her. She'll be the mother of Christ and all generations will call her blessed. Like Isaiah, Mary knows that because the Lord is with her, she receives great meaning and purpose.

John the Baptist finds joy in his mission and purpose as he cries out: "*Make straight the way of the Lord.*" In a time of darkness for his people, John testifies to Christ, "The Light," so that others may have hope and believe through Him. Again, John lives out the purpose given to him and knows the Lord is at hand.

Isaiah, Mary, John, and Paul rejoice because they know the Lord is with them and working through them. They have *Good News* and find it glorious to share it. What is our good news to share? Maybe, like Isaiah, we have good news about meaningful work or service we have been called to. Perhaps, like Mary, we have good news about our blessings of family or friends we've been blessed with. Or perhaps times may be dark today, but like John we have good news about a future filled with hope in Christ.

St. Paul teaches us to "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, and in all circumstances give thanks." We don't do so because our prayers are always answered, or because we're thankful for circumstances that are always in our favor. We do so because in Christ we always have Good News to share. It may not be as dramatic as the news we heard in today's readings, but it's personal and meaningful for us, because we know how the Lord has blessed us and given our lives meaning and purpose.

In the darkness of Advent and always, we look to the light of Christ and celebrate in the Good News we have in Him. In our rejoicing we come to the Lord unceasingly with our needs, as we do in our prayers and petitions. And we give thanks for all of God's gifts, especially the gift of His Son. Can we *rejoice always*? Yes!

Parish Life

Mass Obligations for the 4th Sunday of Advent (Dec. 24th) and Christmas.

Catholics are obliged (blessed!) to attend Mass two times in that period of three days. Either Saturday evening or Sunday morning, for the 4th Sunday of Advent, as well as Sunday evening or Monday morning for Christmas. Technically some canonists argue you could attend two Christmas Masses, one on Sunday and one on Monday or even two on Sunday and fulfill your two obligations. At any rate, please inform the faithful of their obligations to attend two Masses in those three days.

Mass schedule for Christmas: Sunday evening (Dec. 24) at 4:00, 6:30, and 10:00 PM and on Monday (Dec. 25) at 10:00 AM.
