2nd Sunday of Lent

February 25, 2024

This encounter of Peter, James and John upon the mountain with the glorious Christ seems out of place in the Gospel of Mark. Why are they given this vision of the glorious risen Christ before the cross and resurrection? We can, however, turn the question around. Why are the disciples not able to see the glory of Christ at every moment? He is the Son of God, the Word through whom all things are made. Why can they not see this? It is because they have not accepted that Jesus must die on the cross.

After they come down from the mountain Jesus commands them to tell nobody about what has happened until after "the Son of Man [has] risen from the dead". They do not understand what Jesus means by this saying. But as we read Mark's Gospel, we are now seeing all this in the light of the cross and resurrection. We know that without the cross there can be no resurrection. It is only after Jesus has risen that the disciples will understand the significance of what happened upon the mountain. The mountain of the glorious appearance of Jesus only makes sense in the light of that other mountain, Golgotha, the place of the crucifixion. On the cross Christ shares all our pain and suffering; this is Christ's glory.

When we think of earthly glory, we think of those who have risen above our ordinary human weakness and vulnerability. The great sportsperson never experiences the disappointments of the ordinary competitor. Those who are rich and famous do not share in our daily struggles to make a living. Sometimes we think that sharing in the glory of Christ will make us invulnerable to human weakness and suffering. With Peter we say that it is wonderful to be with the glorified Christ, and we wish to build a dwelling place so that Christ can stay forever with us. Yet remaining with Christ means following him to that other mountain, the place of the cross. Jesus enters glory not through rising above our suffering, but by embracing it.

I hope and pray that you are taking advantage of the many graces the advent season presents for us. Especially as we journey toward Jerusalem and the glory of the resurrection. Make this the best lent of your lives.
