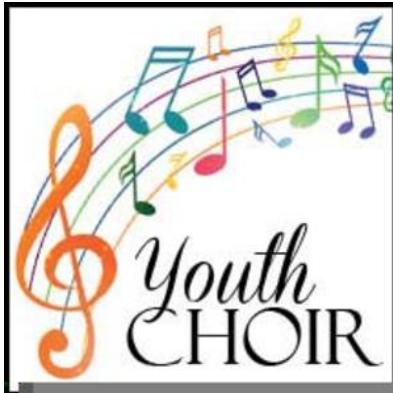

Large storage containers (preferable with lids)

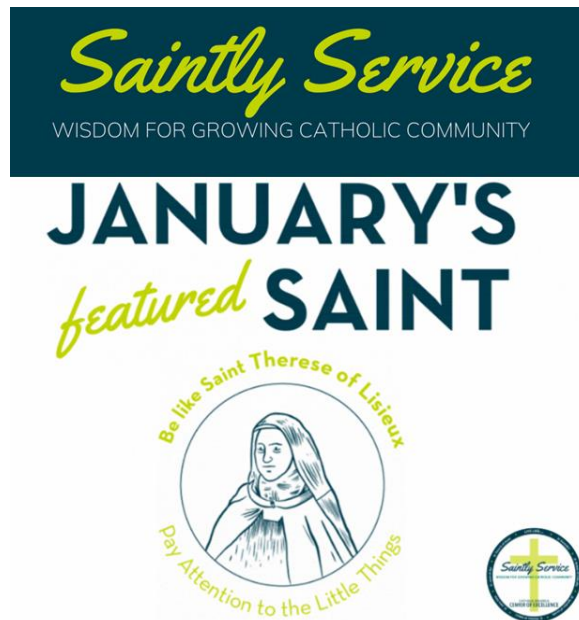
Knives
