The Annual Collection is an important source of funding for the parish's many expenses, including salaries for our talented staff as well as property, utilities and maintenance costs. We ask for your prayerful consideration to assist us in meeting our goal of raising \$73,000.

The average cost to run the parish is \$9,500 per week and our expectation is that 70% -\$6,700 will come from the weekly offertory.

The week ending February 7th, the parishioners contributed \$5,887.
