ECO-TIP OF THE WEEK: Open those windows!!

On some days you can try opening your windows instead of running the air conditioning. This is especially useful on days when it is not too hot or humid. About 100 million tons of carbon dioxide are released into the atmosphere each year due to air conditioners, with an average of two tons per home. Be sure to shut off the A/C when it is not needed, such as at night or on cloudy days. The less you rely on your air conditioning, the more you save. Sometimes an open window is just as good.
