The plan is to plant small, slow growing foundation type shrubs and plants over the next week. It will enhance the front and add a touch of warmth without taking over.

We trimmed the umbrella tree in the front although at a cost that is expensive and apt to be annual. Essentially, a tree that is designed to branch outward more than upward is going to be an issue when planted on a small lot near a building. It's suitability for that spot is something to consider for the future given the cost of maintaining it.
